This letter is to voice my concern for a possible proposed change being considered in the Centennial Airport Part 150 Study. Specifically, recommendation #6.

My concern that ALL pilots look for empty land to make their turn and NOT to fly any further south than the exit 191 (a MAXIMUM 4 mile limit) area or they will be over OUR city of Castle Pines North. If they will stay well north of Surrey Ridge — hopefully it will not impact those residents either. But, I definitely oppose planes routinely (and inadvertently) turning over our community and contributing new noise and safety concerns to our community.

I understand that the present pattern causes noise for Lone Tree and Highlands Ranch. However, when I moved here over 7 years ago, I did so, in part for the quiet. I specifically did not move to areas where I knew there was airplane noise. This was a conscience decision and now- years later it might change. We are a community of over 10,000 people and it is unfair to make a change because the communities to the north of us have complained. People know when the move into those communities that Centennial Airport has always flown in their air-space. Thank you for taking into consideration that we strongly this oppose a change.
