Family and Medical Leave Act Reforms/Birth and Adoption Unemploymen Compensation (BAA-UC) Rule

Additionally, I would request that the BAA-UC rule promulgated by the Department of Labor in 1999 be rescinded. This act allows states to compensate employed workers taking voluntary leave (following the birth or adoption of a child) from their state's unemployment find

The state unemployment fund exists to compensate <u>unemployed</u> workers, not those who are employed and choose not to come to work. I am not saying that some financial support for new parents who choose to stay home should not be considered. However, I do feel that the unemployment fund of a state is <u>not</u> the place to source those funds. Please support the rescinding of BAA-UC and find some other source to meet its objective.
