Construction at airports is now in full swing. Poor planning and practices regarding construction activities can expose the airport to unnecessary risk. It is the responsibility of the airport operator to develop a construction safety plan that complies with AC 150/5370-2E. This plan must be submitted for FAA approval prior to the start of construction. The construction safety plan's primary purpose is to identify project safety concerns, requirements, and impacts prior to making arrangements with contractors and other personnel to perform work on an airport. We have prepared a construction safety plan checklist to aid airport operators in developing their construction safety plan. Please note that the safety plan is in general context and the complexity of the plan should be based on the specific project. Aviation safety is everyone's primary concern, therefore it is critical that all construction at airports be properly planned and coordinated with all parties involved.
