  - Interesting Differences Regarding Caregivers

- Fewer Surveys, Larger Samples
- Sub-national Data Sought
- Caregivers, HDM and Transportation (w/other mods)
- Major Source of GPRA/PART Analysis
- Major Data Source for Title III-B Evaluation

- Software to Edit and Transmit SPR to AoA
- Replaces SPRDIA and Sverify
- **Vendor Used by Many States: SYNERGY/now Harmony**
- **Product Increases State Flexibility** 
  - **WEB Version and Install Version for States**
  - **XML** and Dbase Formats
- Successfully Released in 2005
- On-Line Training and TA Provided
- National Version for AoA use developed

## **AoA Census Data**



- Special Tabulation on Aging 2000
  - Data Tables on: income, poverty, disabilities, race and ethnicity, education, etc.
  - Data for States, PSAs, Counties, Cities, Other Places, and Census Tracts
  - Sent to States, AAAs Excel Format
  - Available on AoA web site
- Annual Population Estimates figures (age, sex, race, ethnicity) for the US, states, and counties
  - Compiled annually by AoA and posted on AoA web site and AGID (county data posting to AGID in progress)
- **S** ACS Tabulation −2004, 2005, 2006
  - Significant State Data for Non-Census Year
  - Detailed Tables of Characteristics by Age
  - Available in Excel on AGID (data.aoa.gov)
- Future ACS Tabulations as ACS replaces the Decennial "Long Form" sample data
