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Note: Within each age group, the different types of disabilities will not equal 100% because a single person can have more than one type of disability, and many persons have no disabilities.

The 2000 United States Census included a long-form questionnaire of roughly 1/6 the noninstitutionalized population over the age of 5 years. As a result, the number of people with disabilities may be under estimates because of comparatively higher rates of institutionalization (e.g., extended care facilities). Six questions were included in the long-form questionnaire regarding disbility:

Does this person have any of the following long-lasting conditions:

- a. Blindness, deafness, or a severe vision or hearing impairment?
- b. A condition that substantially limits one or more basic physical activities such as walking, climbing stairs, reaching, lifting, or carrying?

Because of a physical, mental, or emotional condition lasting 6 months or more, does this person have any difficulty in doing any of the following activities:

- a. Learning, remembering, or concentrating?
- b. Dressing, bathing, or getting around inside the home?
- c. (Answer if this person is 16 YEARS OLD OR OVER.) Going outside the home alone to shop or visit a doctor's office?
- d. (Answer if this person is 16 YEARS OLD OR OVER.) Working at a job or business?
