Dr. Longjohn is currently the Executive Director of the Consortium to Lower Obesity in Chicago Children (CLOCC), one of the largest grassroots childhood obesity prevention efforts in the country. Dr. Longjohn is also a Research Assistant Professor and Lecturer in the Departments of Pediatrics and Preventive Medicine at Northwestern University's Feinberg School of Medicine, and on staff in the Department of Emergency Medicine at the Medical College of Wisconsin. In his academic capacity, he instructs medical and public health students in courses such as "Violence as a Public Health Problem", "Public Health Advocacy, Policy, and Law", and "Integrating Advocacy into Clinical Practice".
