

**New Standard Agency “F-file” submission format for Agencies.  
Effective beginning 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2009**

All agency submissions must be contained in a standard text file and the filename must have a **.txt** extension. The records must be in a fixed-width format, starting at character **1** and ending at character **35** (see table layout below).

The F-file should not contain any header, footer, or title. Only the data itself should be contained in the text file. In the forwarding e-mail you should indicate the total number of records included in the text file.
