<u>New! Information about Rollovers</u> - We have added a new resource to the **Retirement** Plans Community web page (<u>www.irs.gov/ep</u>) for rollovers from qualified retirement plans. The information includes a rollover chart summarizing the rollover rules, FAQs for obtaining a waiver of the 60-day rollover period and resources for additional information. The rollover chart lets the user know at a glance if amounts may be rolled to or from IRA, SEP-IRA, SIMPLE IRA, Roth IRA, 403(b), 457(b), qualified plan and Designated Roth accounts.

Correcting Plan Errors - As we mentioned in the June edition of the Employee Plans Customer Education & Outreach Talking Points, the Correcting Plan Errors web page has recently been redesigned. Since then, we have added a new link called "Q&A's – Recent Outreach Events." The featured questions and answers are based on oral presentations made by IRS officials at the ASPPA web cast on June 6, 2006, entitled, "It's Finally Here. EPCRS Updated" and the June 13, 2006 Tax Talk Today Program - "Why Fix Mistakes in Retirement Plans Now Rather than Later?" The questions were submitted by the attendees and the responses were given at the meetings.

New User Fee Schedule for 2006 - Phase II of the New User Fee Schedule announced in IR-2005-144 is effective July 1, 2006. Under the revised and centralized EP determination letter program, fees for opinion and advisory letters and determination letters involving Forms 5300, 5307 and 5310, which currently range from \$125 to \$6,500, will increase to \$200 to \$15,000.
