(Issued January 11, 2005)

At approximately 2:30 p.m. today, the Commission's staff was advised of a bomb threat and the need to evacuate the Commission's headquarters, 888 First Street, N.E. Washington, D.C. Subsequently, Chairman Wood released all employees from duty at 3:00 p.m.

The emergency closing provisions set forth in the Commission's rules apply to these circumstances and, accordingly, all filings and Commission actions due today are instead due tomorrow, January 12, 2005. *See* 18 C.F.R. section 385.2007 (a)(2).
