The enclosed booklet, "Bankers' Acceptances," is part of an ongoing update and revision of the Comptroller's. Handbook. The booklet replaces the "Bankers' Acceptances" section of the Comptroller's Handbook for National Bank Examiners, dated 1990. The booklet provides detailed guidance to assist in understanding and evaluating bankers' acceptances.

Bankers' acceptances are used to finance trade. "Bankers' Acceptances" includes a discussion of the process of issuance, the acceptances' characteristics, and the risks inherent in these instruments. This booklet incorporates the OCC's supervision by risk philosophy. Procedures guide examiners to conclusions about the quantity of a bank's risk and the quality of its risk management. Examiners should consult this booklet, as needed, if a bank issues bankers' acceptances.
