

Operation Restore Trust Overview

 Began in 1995 as a 2-year demonstration project that developed innovative ways to fight fraud, waste, and abuse in the five states with the largest Medicare and Medicaid benefit payments -New York, California, Illinois, Florida, and Texas

 Accounted for 33% of all Medicare beneficiaries and 38% of all Medicare payments in the USA

What is Operation Restore Trust (ORT)?



- Partnership model in fighting fraud and abuse in Medicare & Medicaid
- Results improve if agencies work together!
- Pataki convened a state work group chaired by the State Long Term Care Ombudsman Program (LTCOP)



ORT in New York State

- As a result of the efforts of Operation Restore Trust, approximately 250,000 individuals have received the anti-fraud waste and abuse message
- NYS \$73,201,200 dollars identified in healthcare fraud & Abuse (double billing Medicare/Medicaid)
- NYS 2001 \$12,400,000 dollars identified



Ten cents out of every dollar spent for Medicare & Medicaid is lost due to Fraud & Abuse!




- 24 hour telephone language service





Operation Restore Trust Database

- Created at Empire Medicare Services to track <u>all</u> allegations received as a result of our participation in ORT
- Query capabilities for -

- Our participation in project ORT began in June 1997
- Allegations received to date is 515

Latest Scams. . .

- Allegation of **illegal blood Glucose test strips** being sold in this country resulting in false readings
- Individual returning home from the hospital receives visitor claiming he was **sent by**Medicare to help organize her hospital papers. How did he know she had been in the hospital? Person with Medicare was robbed
- Medicare beneficiary **receives supplies never ordered** by his physician
- Beneficiary receives call stating that **SSA is issuing new Medicare cards** because of the tragedy at the World Trade Center (computers were lost) beneficiary was asked their Medicare number
- Thousands of dollars in checks made out to doctor for home visits Medicare never billed
- Security Guard at assisted living alerts Medicare that individuals are trying to gain access to Medicare numbers by **asking residents to fill out surveys** including their Medicare numbers
- "Free" mud therapy offered to Medicare beneficiaries in Non-English speaking communities - Medicare billed for physical therapy
