

Public Notice of Voluntary Liquidation

Notice must be made for a period of two months in every issue of a newspaper published in the city or town in which the bank is located, or if no newspaper is there, then in the newspaper published nearest to the bank's location.

Example:

This notice is given pursuant to 12 USC 182 that (*exact corporate name and address (street, city, county, state) of national bank*) is closing its business voluntarily. Notice also has been given to the Comptroller of the Currency, (*address of the district office*), of its plan to liquidate.

The bank is closing its affairs. Any creditor should present its claim for payment against the bank by (*insert date that is no earlier than 14 calendar days after the date of the final newspaper publication of this notice*) either by mail to (*mailing address*) or in person to (*street address*).
