<u>Reservoir Storage</u> June reservoir storages lower than last month for all reservoirs expect New Melones, which gained 62 thousand-acre-feet since last month.


River_Releases Releases were lower than last month for all rivers.

Water_Supply The final classification of WY 2006 based upon May 1st conditions was "Wet."




