Summary of Water Supply Conditions as of 11/30/06

Precipitation averages 6.4 inches for November on the Northern Sierra Eight Station Index. This month, 5.50 inches were recorded, which is approximately 86 percent of the monthly average. This is better than October which was only 18 percent of average. The first few days of December have been dry as well. The Daily snow water equivalent reports have not been updated since the 28th of November when there were 2 inches in the Northern and 1 inch in the Central area, so 0 percent remains in the table below.

Reservoir Storage is above the 15-year averages for all facilities. Cuts have been made on the Sacramento to conserve storage. Flood Control requirements are in effect for facilities, only New Melones is above its flood control maximum, though only by 24,488 acre-feet. Safety-of-Dams criteria have gone into effect for Trinity, which at 1,749 thousand-acre-feet is well below the November (and December) limit of 1,850 thousand-acre-feet.


River Releases are above their 15-year medians for all facilities. Trinity River release is at its winter low point of 300 cfs. Releases at Goodwin have been at 600 cfs since November 1st, for fishery spawning, but are scheduled to increase to 800 cfs for reservoir storage management.

Water Supply Forecasts for Water Year 2007 will begin mid-December 2006.




