- Awarded October 28, 2005
- •5 year IDIQ contract, multiple award
- •21 vendors 15 large businesses; 6 small businesses
- Three principle task areas:
 - Information Systems Services (ISS)
 - Systems Security Services (SSS)
 - Strategic Business Services (SBS)
- Customers: Treasury bureaus, DHS & DOJ

TIPSS-4 Strategy

- Multi-year contract with multiple vendors
- Approximate budget: \$500M per year
- Shift in business emphasis
 - Increased opportunities for Small Business
 - Tiered Approach (Cascade)
 - Better pricing from Industry
 - Increase use of FFP orders
 - Streamline procurement process
 - Reduce award time of task orders
 - Increase use of Performance-Based Statements of Work and Statements of Objectives
