

**OFFENDERS IN NEW JERSEY CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS  
ON JANUARY 12, 2004, BY BASE OFFENSE**

In these tabulations, the base offense is that which is the most serious offense at the time of admission. These figures reflect base or controlling offenses at admission only, and do not include any offenses in addition to the base offense in the case of multiple sentences at admission. Additional sentences imposed following initial admission to the state correctional system are not included in these data.

- Violent offenses include homicide, sexual assault, aggravated and simple assault, robbery, kidnapping, other sex offenses and other person offenses (i.e. terroristic threats, coercion, larceny from a person, death by auto and negligent manslaughter).
- Property offenses include burglary, arson, theft, forgery, embezzlement, and receiving / possessing stolen property.
- Public policy offenses include racketeering, gambling, corruption, perjury, escape, bail jumping, juvenile and family related offenses and conspiracy.
- Weapons offenses include weapon possession and operation.
- Drug violations include distribution, manufacture, possession and use of drugs. Virtually all drug offenses are for sale and distribution rather than for mere possession.

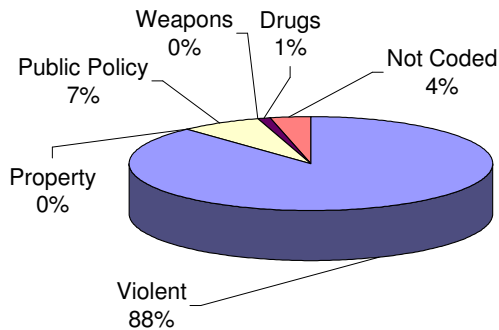

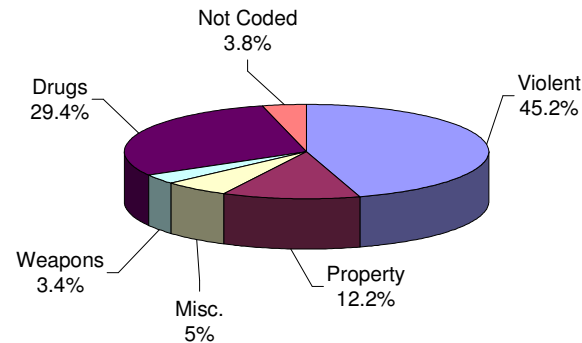

Virtually all offenders at ADTC were committed for violent offenses

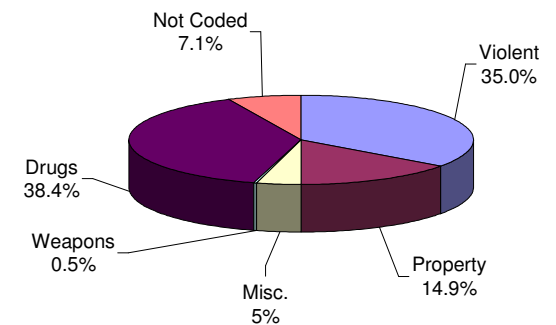
### PRISON MALES



Forty-five percent (45%) of male offenders in the prison complex were convicted of a violent offense (ADTC excluded).

Twenty-nine percent (29%) of all male prison complex offenders were convicted of drug offenses.

### FEMALE FACILITIES



Drug offenses are the most frequent commitment offense at Edna Mahan (38%).

Thirty-five percent of female residents were committed for violent offenses compared with 45% for male prison complex residents.

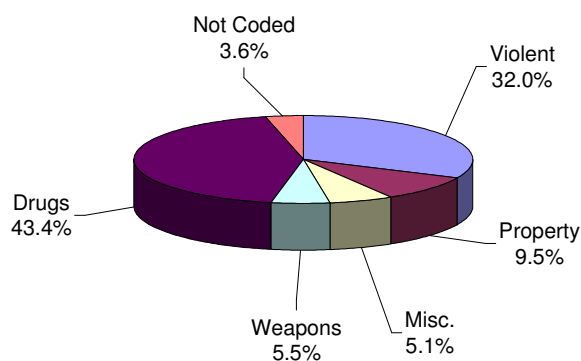

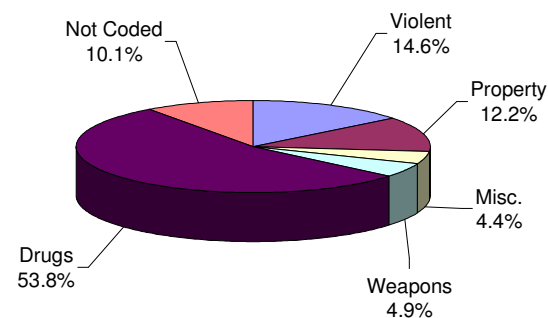

#### YOUTH COMPLEX



Forty-three percent (43%) of offenders housed in the youth complex were incarcerated for drug offenses.

#### OFFENDERS IN OTHER FACILITIES



Offenders housed in county jails and halfway houses are less serious offenders than those found in the prison complex facilities (i.e. 14% violent offenses vs. 45% violent offenses in prison complex).
