PERFORMANCE OF THERAPEUTIC LASER EYE PROCEDURES IN VETERANS HEALTH ADMINISTRATION FACILITIES

- **1. PURPOSE:** This Veterans Health Administration (VHA) Directive specifies that only ophthalmologists will be privileged to perform therapeutic laser eye procedures in Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) medical facilities. *NOTE:* VHA Directive 2004-045, Laser Eye Procedures, is rescinded.
- **2. BACKGROUND:** VHA Directive 2004-045, issued August 24, 2004, provided that optometrists with appropriate training and licensure could be given authority to perform therapeutic laser eye procedures under the supervision of an ophthalmologist.
- **3. POLICY:** It is VHA policy that therapeutic laser eye procedures only be performed by ophthalmologists with the requisite training and expertise.
- **4. ACTION:** Each medical center Director is responsible for ensuring that privileges to perform laser eye procedures are granted to ophthalmologists with the requisite training and expertise.
