Labor Requirements and Tools and Equipment

Estimated labor requirements for unpacking

At least two workers to unload truck. It should take approximately an hour to unload.

Estimated labor requirements for installation:

Two workers will be needed to install the exhibition, four are recommended. It is estimated that it will take no more than one day to install the exhibition.

Estimated labor requirements for de-installation

Two workers, preferably the same workers who installed the exhibition, will be needed to de-install the exhibition. It is estimated that de-installation will take two to three hours.

Estimated labor requirements for packing:

At least two workers are needed to load truck. It should take approximately one hour to load the truck.

Equipment needed for unloading and loading truck

All crates containing the exhibition structures are a suitcase style with wheels for easy transport. Dollies may be requires for the 6 Audio/Visual crates, and the truck should be equipped with one.

Tools to be provided by the host venue for installation

Table and chairs – to set up 4 tabletop computer systems with touch screen interactive computer program in section 3 of the exhibition, *Authors and Their Books*. Configuration is to the discretion of the host institution.

Step ladder – 4' or 6' height to connect header panels.

Surge protectors – to be attached to all audio visual elements as a precaution, particularly on the 4 free-standing kiosks.

Extension **cords** and **power strips** may be required depending on the placement of the audio visual elements. We also recommend the use of OSHA approved cord molding or duct tape to secure and protect the electrical cords that may need to run across the exhibition space.



Suitecase style crates


These crates contain all of the exhibition panel structures.

Each set of accordioned panel systems is a set of 3, 4, 5 or 6 folds. Each fully assembled fold has three inset pieces. The lower two pieces are parts **B** and **C**, and they do not disassemble – only fold down for storage. The third piece, part **A**, is separate from these, and must be attached on top as an individual piece (see drawings below). All panels are numbered sequentially to match the desired flow of the exhibition content.

The crates do not need to be opened in any specific order, but we recommend placing the crates in the general area of the room where that portion of the exhibition will be displayed before opening and unpacking each crate. The introductory section (timeline) should be at the beginning of the exhibition, and the title kiosk can be placed wherever seems most appropriate to the space.




fully assembled and installed panel system




Deinstallation and Packing



1. Unlock and fold down all panel systems.



2. Reattach Velcro strap, and return them to their crates as labeled. Make sure a piece of cardboard remains between each layer.





- 3. Secure strapping on outside of crates.
- 4. Return each AV kiosk to their crates as labeled.

Routine Maintenance

This exhibition was designed to be care-free. However, the surfaces may require cleaning. All exhibition components, including the structures themselves, AV kiosks, and computer monitors can be cleaned with a normal glass cleaner. Do not apply clearer directly onto the screen, but rather apply cleaner to paper towel or cloth and then use to clean the glass. Be cautious of getting the electronics themselves damp.

If any serious damage occurs, please do not attempt to make any repairs yourself. **Please report any damage or malfunction immediately to USHMM Traveling Exhibitions**, 202.314.0325, so a replacement panel can be ordered, or a technician can be sent.

USHMM will provide service to AV kiosks periodically throughout the exhibition's tour to dust internally.
