Dear Mr. Kozey:

1. On April 6, 2005, as amended on April 14, 2005, the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (Midwest ISO) filed proposed revisions to its Transmission and Energy Markets Tariff (TEMT) to comply with the Commission's March 16, 2005 order in this proceeding.¹ The March 16 Order directed the Midwest ISO, among other things, to: (1) revise certain TEMT tariff sheets to reflect the change in the start of financially binding market operations from March 1, 2005 to April 1, 2005; and (2) correct the use of the capitalized phrase "First Revised" on certain sheets.
2. The March 16 Order further directed the Midwest ISO to make the following filings by May 16, 2005: (1) an informational filing detailing its progress in establishing communication links with control areas' back-up facilities, to help ensure reliability of system operations in the event the control areas' primary control centers fail; and (2) a filing that properly identifies all of the prior Commission orders that were a source of the TEMT revisions in the Midwest ISO's December 22, 2004 compliance filing. The Midwest ISO states that it intends to address the above compliance obligations on or before May 16, 2005.

3. Notices of the filing and the amendment were published in the *Federal Register*, 70 Fed Reg. 20,889 (2005) and 70 Fed. Reg. 22,023 (2005), with interventions and protests due on or before April 27, 2005 and May 5, 2005, respectively. None were filed.

4. Upon review, the Commission finds that the Midwest ISO has complied with the March 16 Order directives and conditionally accepts the filing, as amended, subject to the conditions below.

5. In the case of tariff sheets not yet approved in other pending proceedings, we conditionally accept the filing subject to the outcome of the relevant pending proceedings. We also note that certain tariff sheets identified in the Appendix to this order do not fully comply with the requirements of Order No. 614.² Accordingly, the Midwest ISO is directed to re-file the tariff sheets listed in the Appendix within 60 days of the issuance of this letter order, to make the corrections outlined in the Appendix.
