Detroit Quarantine Station

Jurisdiction

The jurisdiction of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's (CDC) Detroit Quarantine Station includes all ports in Michigan, Ohio, and Kentucky.

Quarantine Station Activities

- Respond to reports of illness or death on airplanes, maritime vessels (cargo), and other conveyances at international ports of entry in the states of Michigan, Ohio, and Kentucky.
- Partner with other federal agencies, local and state health departments, private medical providers, and hospitals in preparedness activities related to quarantine and isolation at ports of entry (e.g., Michigan Department of Community Health Great Lakes Border Health Initiative)
- Establish planning logistics, along with our public health partners, for emergency public health and bioterrorism response.
- Participate in teams and workgroups for CDC's Division of Global Migration and Quarantine, Quarantine and Border Health Services Branch.
