



EXPLANATION OF LEGEND

Roads Open to Highway Legal Vehicle Only:

These roads are open only to motor vehicles licensed under State law for general operation on all public roads within the State.

Seasonal Designation:

This symbol, used in conjunction with one of the other road or trail symbols, indicates that the road or trail is open only during certain portions of the year. Refer to the Seasonal Designation Table for further instructions.

Dispersed Camping:

This symbol is used along with a designated road or trail to indicate that limited cross-country motor vehicle use is allowed within a specific distance of that route, solely for the purpose of dispersed camping. Motorized Access to dispersed camping sites is only allowed on National Forest System Land and only on the side of the routes where the symbol is displayed. Refer to the Dispersed Camping Table for specifics.

DISPERSED CAMPING TABLE

Motor vehicle use off of designated roads for the purpose of dispersed camping is permitted for up to 300 feet from the centerline of the road allowing the same vehicles as the road allows and the same season as the road is open. This applies to the following Forest Service roads:

Dispersed camping access applies only to National Forest System land. A majority of the land within the boundaries of the Pawnee National Grassland is privately owned. Be sure you are on the National Grassland before driving off a road for camping. PLEASE RESPECT PRIVATE LAND, GATES, FENCES, STOCK TANKS, WINDMILLS AND OTHER PRIVATE PROPERTY.
