## ONE DAY'S NOTICE FOR MODIFICATION OF UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENT

## ORDER OF THE SENATE

A unanimous consent agreement providing for a vote on the final passage of a bill on a specified day operates, under Rule XII, as an order of the Senate.1

A unanimous consent agreement providing for a vote on a specified day upon a bill through the regular parliamentary stages to its final disposition operates as an order of the Senate.<sup>2</sup>

An order of the Senate (which results from the adoption of a resolution or the granting of a unanimous consent request) requiring Senators to vote from their desks, has the same force and effect as the provision of the Standing Rules of the Senate.3

It is not appropriate to adopt an order of the Senate to request a report by committee staff members.4
