Dear OTS,

I have reviewed your memorandum issued January 30, 2003 regarding proposed revisions to the TFR for March, 2004. Most of the proposed revisions I have no problem with. However, the proposed revision for a shorter deadline on filing the TFR is very problematic. The shorter deadline for filing CMR would not present a problem. Frankly, I don't know how any one could not prepare the TFR and CMR at the same time since they should balance to each other. Most quarters I don't have the TFR completed until the final week of the filing month. There are many other accounting responsibilities to be attended to especially in the month after a quarter ends. Having till the end of the filing month provides some "breathing room" to get everything accomplished. I would be in favor of a shorter deadline if less data was required but I don't foresee that occurring. I strongly oppose this revision.
