RE: Proposed rule implementing section 711, CRA Sunshine Requirements of the enacted Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act.

This letter comments on the Agencies Proposed Rule on Disclosure and Reporting of CRA-Related Agreements implementing section 711, CRA Sunshine Requirements, of the recently enacted Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act.

I am writing this letter on behalf of First Citizens Bank & Trust Company, a statechartered bank and Atlantic States Bank, a federal savings association.



General Comments

- 1. Limit disclosure only to formal agreements between financial institutions and community organizations that have expressed concerns to agencies regarding the financial institutions CRA program. These formal agreements would be made available to the agencies and copies upon request to the general public.
- 2. All agreements developed in the ordinary course of doing business that may have a CRA impact, i.e. opening of branches in low-moderate income areas in stores, with consultants, and commercial transactions should be exempt from the GLB Act.
- 3. The agencies should review the agreements during their normal examination process and note for the record the results of the agreement in lieu of annual reporting.

We appreciate the opportunity to comment on the proposal.
