Application

This bulletin is being sent to Part 139 Airport Managers and State Aviation Directors in Iowa, Kansas, Missouri and Nebraska

Background:

Part 139.303(c) requires airport operators to train airport personnel with responsibilities in the airport certification program. Part 139.327(b)(3) requires each certificate holder shall provide the following training for self-inspection personnel:

(3) Procedures to ensure qualified personnel perform the inspections. Such procedures shall ensure personnel are trained, as specified under Sec. 139.303, and receive initial and recurrent instruction every 12 consecutive calendar months in at least the following areas:

- *(i)* Airport familiarization, including airport signs, marking and lighting.
- (ii) Airport emergency plan.
- (iii) Notice to Airmen (NOTAM) notification procedures.
- (iv) Procedures for pedestrians and ground vehicles in movement areas and safety areas.
- (v) Discrepancy reporting procedures;

Enclosed *(Contact Mike Mullen for copies)* are copies of a DVD titled, "Airport Safety Self-Inspection", which are provided by the Office of Airport Safety and Standards, FAA National Headquarters, Washington, D.C. This DVD provides general training for airport maintenance and operations personnel to supplement the airport site-specific training material developed at each airport.

ACTION NEEDED:

Airport operators should provide this training DVD to the airport personnel responsible for maintaining and inspecting the airport.
