Archives Exhibits Mark 1906 San Francisco Earthquake Centennial

At 5:12 am, April 18, 1906, a catastrophic earthquake measuring near 8 on the Richter Scale shook California, rupturing 270 to 290 miles along the San Andreas Fault from Humboldt County in the north to San Benito County in the south. Towering, massive, fast-moving post-quake fires fueled and compounded the destruction, raging through San Francisco for three days following the quake, due to its having shattered the city's safety infrastructure, including the entire water system. In the aftermath of the earthquake and fire, over 250,000 people--more than half of San Francisco's population--became homeless. Refugee camps sprang up

around the city. Hospitals were filled with the injured, many of whom did not survive.

Federal agencies and personnel were among 'first responders,' to the disaster and directly involved in furious efforts to preserve public order; to save lives, public buildings, and community assets; and to care for

a stricken population. Some recorded vivid contemporary accounts of the event.

With the help of NARA headquarters staff, the Regional Archives at San Bruno created a portable exhibit of documents and images illustrating the federal response to the 1906 earthquake and fire. During spring 2006, the NARA exhibit was put on view at federal and municipal government buildings and thematic conferences and seminars in the Bay Area. Archives Director Daniel Nealand was interviewed on Current TV (Al Gore's channel) regarding the exhibit. In addition, original documents from San Bruno's holdings were included in the Oakland Museum of California's major "Aftershock!" exhibit.
