Brigadier General Jeffrey J. Dorko assumed command of the Gulf Region Division, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Baghdad, Iraq on Oct. 10, 2007. His previous assignment was commander of the Southwestern Division, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers from June 2004 to August 2007. Brig. Gen. Dorko oversaw 3,000 engineering and construction professionals in the Dallas-based headquarters and four district offices located in Little Rock, Ark., Tulsa, Okla., and Fort Worth and Galveston, Texas. The division area covers all or part of seven states with annual programs totaling over \$2 billion. Prior to this assignment, Brig. Gen. Dorko served as the Chief of Staff, U.S. Army Maneuver Support Center and Fort Leonard Wood, Fort Leonard Wood, Mo., from July 2002 to June 2004.

Brig. Gen. Dorko served as the Commander of the Engineer Brigade, 1st Cavalry Division, Fort Hood, Texas from July 2000 to July 2002.

He attended the Industrial College of the Armed Forces from 1997 to 1998, and subsequently served as Operations and Plans Officer, Dissemination Division, National Imagery and Mapping Agency in Reston, Va.

From 1995 to 1997 Brig. Gen. Dorko commanded the 10th Engineer Battalion, 3rd Infantry Division which re-flagged as the 9th Engineer Battalion, 1st Infantry Division, Schweinfurt, Germany.

Brig. Gen. Dorko has held a wide variety of Army command and staff assignments. These include duty as Military Assistant for Base Realignments and Closures, Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Installations, Logistics and Environment, Washington, D.C.; Battalion S3, 10th Engineer Battalion, Brigade Engineer, 1st Brigade, 3rd Infantry Division, Schweinfurt, Germany; staff officer, Executive Actions Divisions, Office of the Chief of Staff of the Army; Operations Officer, Military Construction Directorate, HQUSACE; Commander 503rd Engineer Company and Brigade Executive officer, 7th Engineer Brigade Ludwigsburg, Germany; Company Executive Officer and Assistant Battalion S3 299th Engineer Battalion, Fort Sill, Okla.

Brig. Gen. Dorko graduated from the United States Military Academy in 1978. He later received Masters Degrees in Construction Management from the George Washington University and in National Security Strategy from the Industrial College of the Armed Forces. His military education includes the Engineer Officers Basic and Advanced Courses and U.S. Army Command and General Staff College. He was born in Sandusky, Ohio and is married with one child.
