

VACMAN Version 4.1.3.1 Summary of Changes from V 3.0.11

Note: This document highlights changes from VACMAN v3.0.11 to the new VACMAN v4x release. Changes as of version 4.1.2 are indicated as **v4.1.2**, and changes as of version 4.1.3 are indicated as **v4.1.3**. Version 4.1.3.1 supersedes and corrects two issues with the initial release of version 4.1.3. Those issues concerned transmission of flu orders and maximum doses administered in a series.

VACMAN version 4x supports the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program's transition to centralized distribution, which replaces project depot inventory and distribution functions. This significantly changes the role of Bulk Orders, and introduces new Provider Orders screens. Tracking and maintenance of funding within VACMAN are eliminated.

For centralized distribution, CDC utilizes VFC (primary) and G317 (secondary) funds to place large volume orders to manufacturers. Manufacturers ship to distributors throughout the country. One such distributor depot services your project's orders.

Your project specifies shipment from the distributor depot to your enrolled providers by using the new *Provider Orders* screens. These screens accommodate all but frozen vaccines. The Direct Ship function, for frozen vaccines, is generally unchanged. The \$25,000 maximum per order applies.

Note: Medimmune FluMist® is no longer a Direct Ship (frozen) vaccine.

The *Provider Orders* screens accommodate CDC contract vaccines and non-CDC contract vaccine orders.

A new user-requested feature is the *Order Entry* screen. This accommodates orders for multiple vaccines for one provider. The system generates a mirror *Provider Orders* screen, *Influenza Orders* screen, or *Direct Ship Orders* screen, for each order. Similarly, after orders are transmitted, the system generates a mirror *Receipts* screen for each order.

Non-CDC contract vaccine orders are filled based on distributor inventory that projects replenish through the state-funded, non-CDC contract process. The project can then distribute vaccine via the *Provider Orders* screens. Indicate on the *Provider Orders* screen that the order is for non-CDC contract vaccines.

A new user-requested feature is the ability to delay transmitting flu orders. To accommodate this request, flu vaccine has a separate order screen. Orders will remain in a "staging area" until you choose to transmit them. This choice is available on the *Exchange Data with CDC* screen.

As of **v4.1.2**, another new feature is the ability to suspend ordering for a provider. To do this, check *Suspend Provider Ordering* box the on the *Providers* screen – *Main* tab.

In VACMAN v4x, Bulk Orders are only for state-funded (Funding Code 3) vaccine orders. Your bulk-ordered vaccine ships from the manufacturer to the distributor.

In summary:

- Use the *Order Entry* screen to order multiple vaccines for one provider.
- Use the *Provider Orders* screen to order a single vaccine for one provider.
- Use the *Influenza Orders* screen to order flu vaccine for one provider.
- Use the *Direct Ship Orders* screen to order frozen vaccine for one provider. Choose Funding Code 1, 2, or 3.
- Another new screen, *Order History*, shows detail and status of all orders for the selected provider.
- Use the *Bulk Orders* screen to order state-funded vaccine to replenish distributor inventory. The system applies Funding Code 3; the state purchase order number is required.

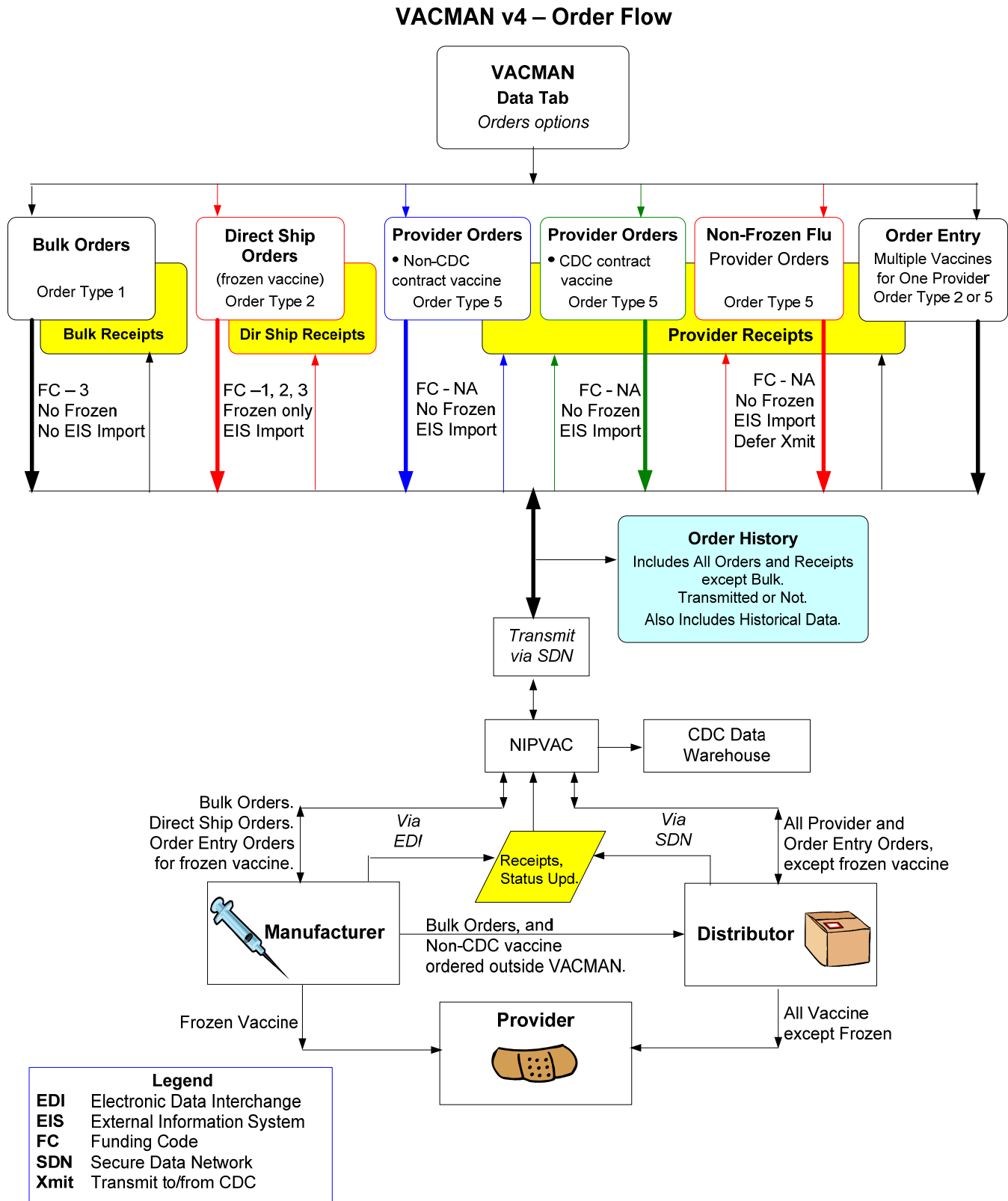
For centralized distribution, shipping instructions are required and must be in a specific format for provider orders. A new screen, available via *Providers – Addresses* tab, enables this input. The system may direct you to the shipping instructions screen during the provider order entry **Save** process.

On the *Setup* tab, review and edit both **Provider Order Vaccines** and **Non-CDC Vaccines**. Choose whether the vaccines should display for selection, and create shortcuts if applicable. Enter *Cost* for non-CDC vaccines.

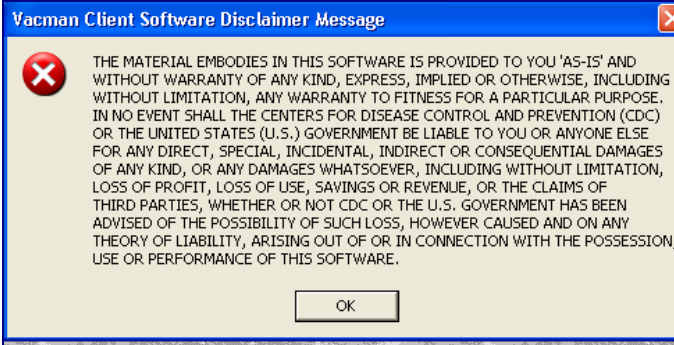
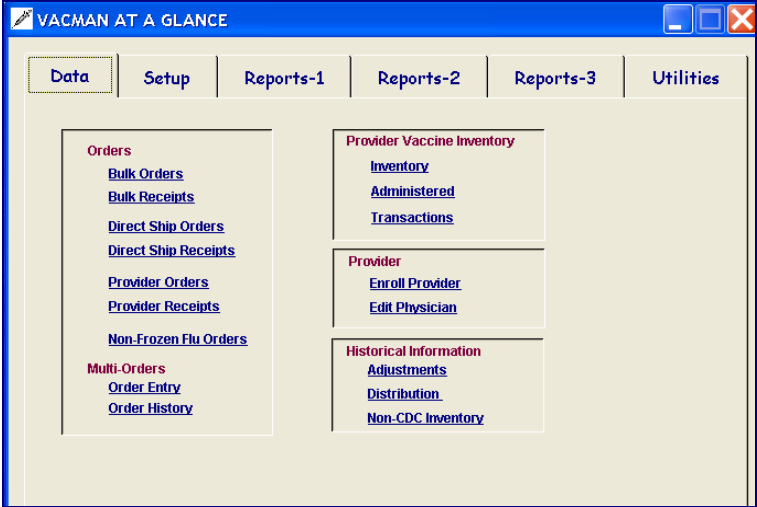
The following flowchart presents an overview of VACMAN v4x order processing.

It lets you enter orders for

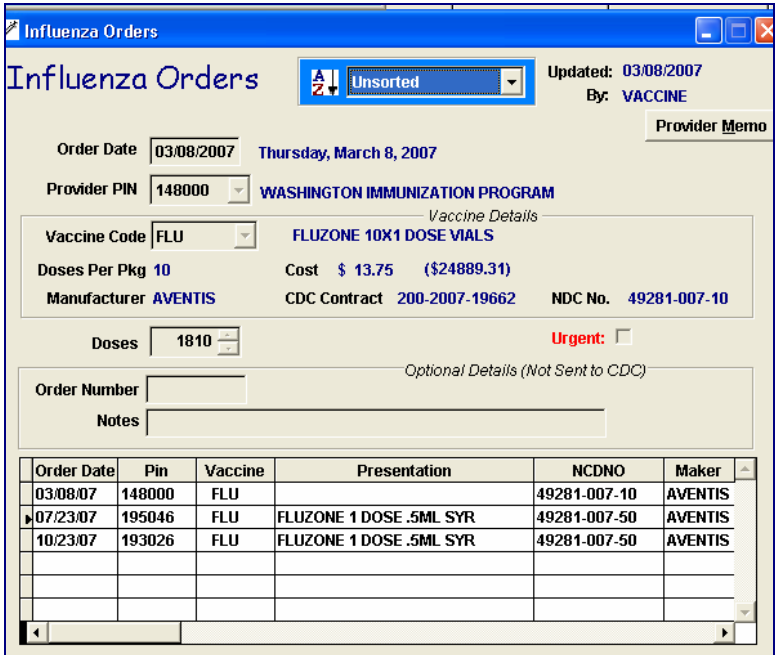

You can enter orders for any vaccine including non-CDC contract vaccines and CDC contract vaccines, frozen or non-frozen.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Order History - Under the new Multi-Orders heading, this option accesses the new <i>Order History</i> screen. You can view detail and status of all orders for a selected provider. <p>Other <i>Data</i> tab options changed as follow:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Transactions – one option now accesses provider, direct ship, and, as of v4.1.2, historical distribution transactions; they are combined on one screen. • Adjustments and Distribution – access historical information about project vaccine inventory. 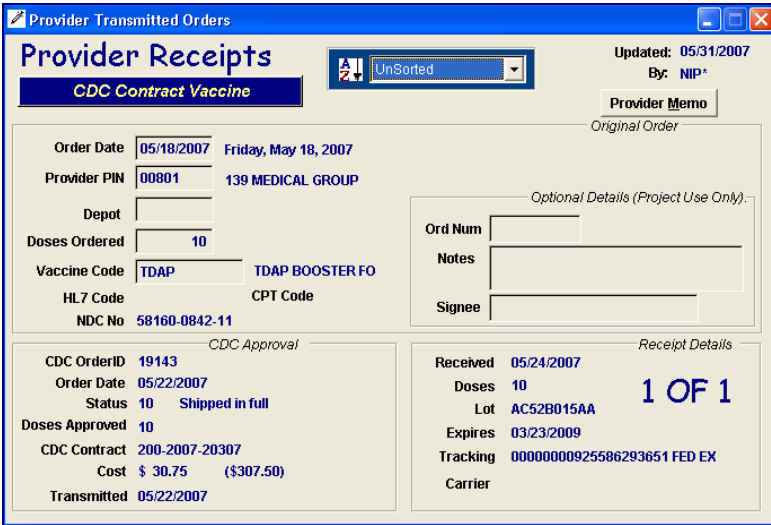
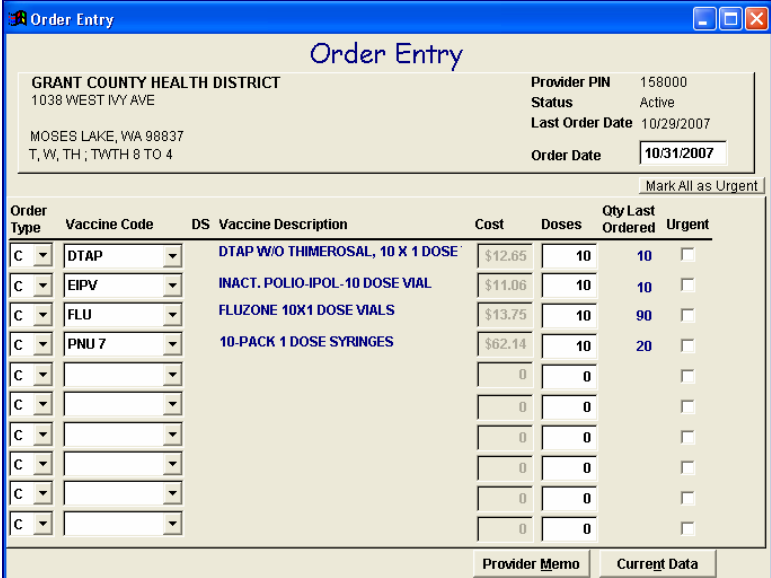

Data	Provider Orders	7.	 <p>Figure 4. New v4x Provider Orders screen.</p> <p>Use this new screen to order one vaccine for shipment to one provider. Notice that the Order Type radio buttons allow you to choose CDC contract vaccines or non-CDC contract vaccines.</p> <p>These orders transmit to the central distributor that serves your project. Your project’s central distributor is the <i>Depot</i> on applicable screens. Orders ship from your distributor to the provider.</p> <p>You now have the ability to flag an order as Urgent. The VACMAN team recommends that you use this feature only when there is real need for overnight, next-day delivery. There is an additional cost for this handling. The system creates a mirror <i>Provider Orders</i> screen when you use the <i>Order Entry</i> screen to enter multiple orders for a provider.</p> <p>Non-CDC Contract Vaccines</p> <p>Non-CDC contract vaccines continue to be ordered outside the VACMAN system. Instruct the manufacturer or supplier to ship to your central depot, and use the <i>Provider Order</i> screen, <i>Non-CDC vaccines</i> radio button, to distribute these vaccines to providers.</p> <p>For VACMAN v4x, the non-CDC contract vaccines that projects can order are limited to those that display in the <i>Vaccine Code</i> drop down box. Projects provide input to CDC as to which vaccines to include. CDC updates the Non-CDC vaccine list periodically.</p> <p>Shipping Instructions</p> <p>If shipping instructions for this provider have not been updated to v4x requirements, the system displays an error message, and re-directs you to the <i>Provider Shipping Modifications</i> screen. See the Enroll Provider option below (Reference 16).</p>

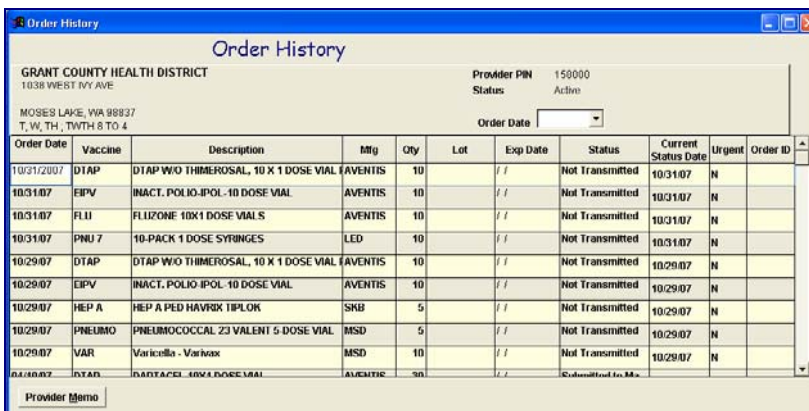

Data	Influenza Orders	8.	 <p>Figure 5. New v4x Influenza Orders screen.</p> <p>Use this new screen only for flu vaccine. VACMAN v4x handles these vaccines separately from other vaccines, so that you can <u>delay</u> transmitting these flu orders. Until you transmit them, they remain as orders in the grid on the lower portion of this screen. You can browse and edit these orders.</p> <p>If you order flu vaccine on the <i>Order Entry</i> screen, the system mirrors the order on this grid.</p> <p>On the <i>Exchange Data with CDC</i> screen, you can choose to include these flu orders in the package you are going to transmit. A new popup screen offers that option. Once you transmit these orders, they process with other orders and subsequently become <i>Provider Receipts</i>.</p> <p>Shipping Instructions</p> <p>If shipping instructions for this provider have not been updated to v4x requirements, the system displays an error message, and re-directs you to the <i>Provider Shipping Modifications</i> screen. See the Enroll Provider option below (Reference 16).</p> <p>As of v4.1.3, you can flag flu orders as Urgent. Use this feature cautiously, as expedited shipping is a cost factor.</p>

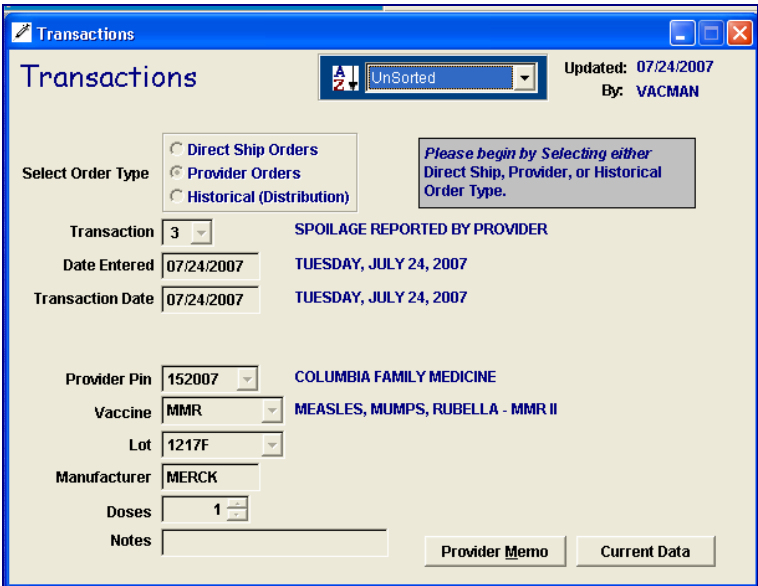

Data	Provider Receipts	9.	 <p>Figure 6. New v4x Provider Receipts screen.</p> <p>Use this new screen to review the status of provider orders that have been transmitted. Notice that it includes system-filled <i>Depot PIN</i>, <i>Tracking</i> and <i>Carrier</i> fields. Provider Receipts include receiving for all provider orders. The field <i>CDC OrderID</i> replaces the previous field <i>CDC PO</i> as of v4.1.2. This applies only to <i>Provider Receipts</i>.</p> <p>As of v4.1.3, you can search <i>Provider Receipts</i> by Order ID.</p> <p>As of v4.1.3, an issue regarding system record overwriting has been resolved.</p> <p>As of v4.1.3, an indicator flagging multiple receipts has been added.</p>
Data	Order Entry	10.	 <p>Figure 7. New v4x Order Entry screen.</p> <p>Use this screen to order multiple vaccines for one provider. Use a separate row for each vaccine.</p> <p>You can order any CDC contract vaccines and non-CDC contract vaccines</p>

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			<p>on this screen.</p> <p>As of v4.1.3, you can flag all orders on the screen as Urgent rather than checking individual boxes.</p> <p>As of v4.1.3, you can access Provider Memo and Current Data via this screen without being in Edit mode.</p> <p>Note: For non-CDC contract vaccines, see the <i>Setup</i> tab – <i>Non-CDC Contract Vaccines</i> screen. You can choose which vaccines you want to be available in <i>Vaccine Code</i> drop down lists for non-CDC contract vaccines on this and the <i>Provider Order</i> screen. Although you can enter the cost per dose directly on the <i>Order Entry</i> screen, the VACMAN team recommends that you maintain this value on the <i>Setup – Provider Vaccine Types</i> screen, for efficiency and to ensure consistency.</p> <p>On the <i>Order Entry</i> screen, you can choose non-frozen flu vaccine for this provider. However, flu orders do not transmit until you choose that option on the <i>Exchange Data with CDC</i> screen.</p> <p>You can choose frozen (Direct Ship) vaccine for this provider. The system prompts you to verify the <i>Funding Code</i>. You can edit the <i>Funding Code</i> on the pop up message.</p> <p>The <i>Last Order Date</i> field was added as of v4.1.2.</p>
Data	Order History	11.	 <p>Figure 8. New v4x Order History screen.</p> <p>The <i>Order History</i> screen displays records that were entered through the <i>Provider Order</i>, <i>Direct Ship Order</i>, <i>Non-Frozen Flu</i>, and multi <i>Order Entry</i> screens, as well as any existing orders in <i>Provider Receipts</i>, <i>Direct Ship Receipts</i> and <i>Distribution</i>.</p> <p>By default, the most recent order is the first record. To see orders for a specific date, type in the <i>Order Date</i> field.</p> <p>As of v4.1.3, an issue with the Alt+H shortcut to access this screen has been corrected.</p> <p>As of v4.1.3, an issue with vaccine descriptions has been resolved.</p>
Data	Project Vaccine Inventory	12.	<p>All of the previous <i>Project Vaccine Inventory</i> options access historical data, and are view-only. The previous options Adjustments and Distribution now display under the heading <i>Historical Information</i> on the <i>Data</i> tab. Data	Enroll Provider	18.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Access to the <i>Enrollment</i> screen is directly from the <i>Provider</i> main tab. It no longer is an option on the <i>Data</i> tab. As of v4.1.2, a new check box field, <i>Suspend Provider Ordering</i>, lets you prohibit Provider Orders for a provider. Check this box to prohibit orders. Note: To prohibit Direct Ship orders for a provider, uncheck the <i>Direct Ship Eligible</i> box. However, the distributor requirement is that shipping instructions must be in a specific format for all vaccines – not just frozen ones. <p>Shipping Instructions</p> <p>In previous versions of VACMAN, <i>Shipping Instructions</i> has been a free-form field of up to 50 characters. A centralized distribution requirement is that the instructions be formatted. VACMAN v4x contains a dialog box to facilitate edits to this field. The Update Ship Instruction button accesses the <i>Provider Shipping Instructions Modification</i> screen; see Figure 10.</p> <p>Shipping instructions is a two-part field. The first part is for essential week days and hours information. The second part can contain additional information, such as “closed 1 to 2”, as might be the case at lunchtime.</p> <p>Both sections combined still cannot exceed 50 characters. The system displays as much of the second part of the field as possible. You can edit as needed to include vital information. If the instructions are complex – for example, different lunchtimes each day – you can specify hours that are consistent every day. Default hours are 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.</p> <p>The instructions can only include alphabetic characters, numeric characters, and just these two special characters: comma (,) and semi-colon (;).</p> <p>Note that hyphens (-) and colons (:) cannot be used.</p> <p>“Friday” – Click the Friday box to replicate formatted instructions in the two format fields. To eliminate Friday as a delivery day, click and then unclick the Friday box.</p> <p>Note: You must click the Save button on both the <i>Provider Shipping Instructions Modification</i> screen and the <i>Providers</i> screen – <i>Addresses</i> tab, VACMAN tool bar.</p>

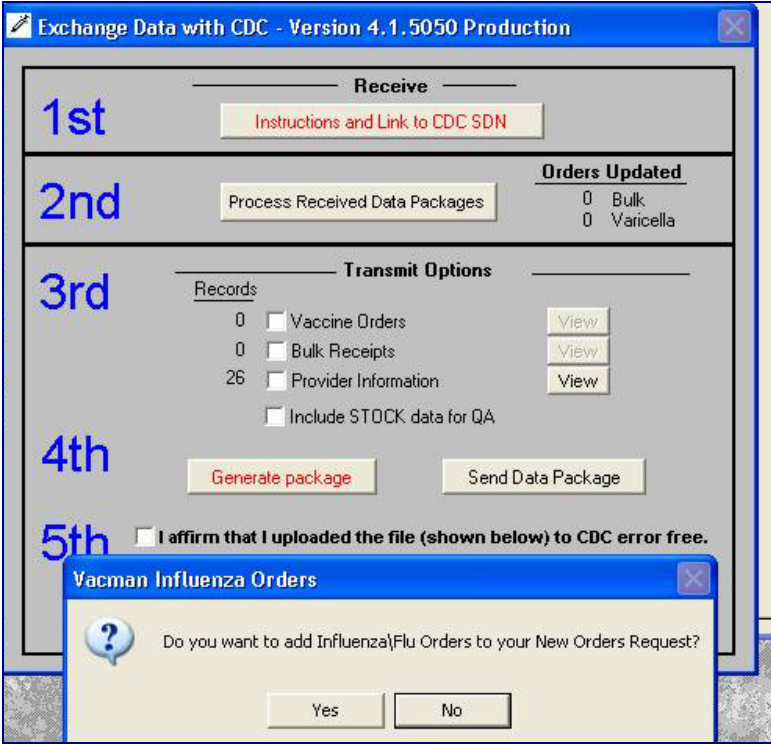

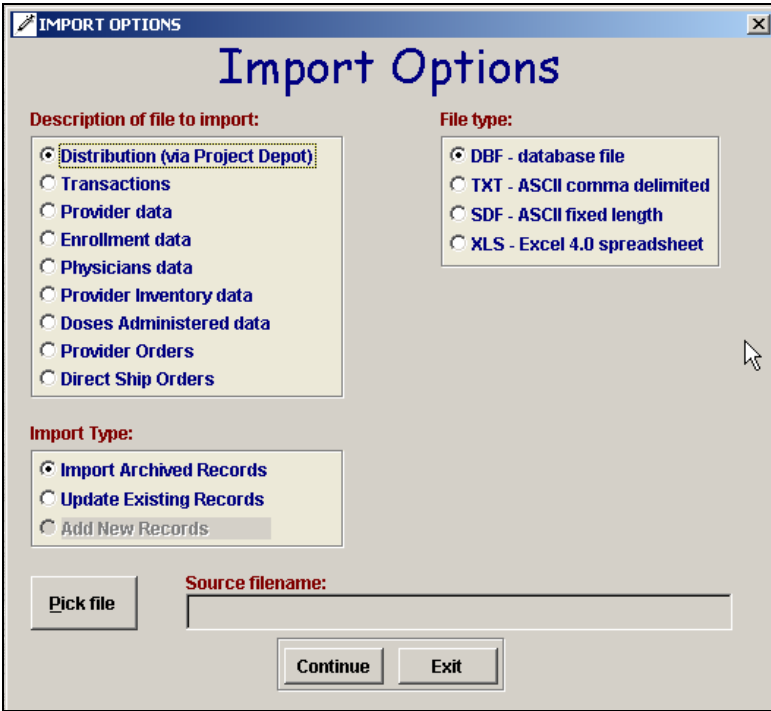
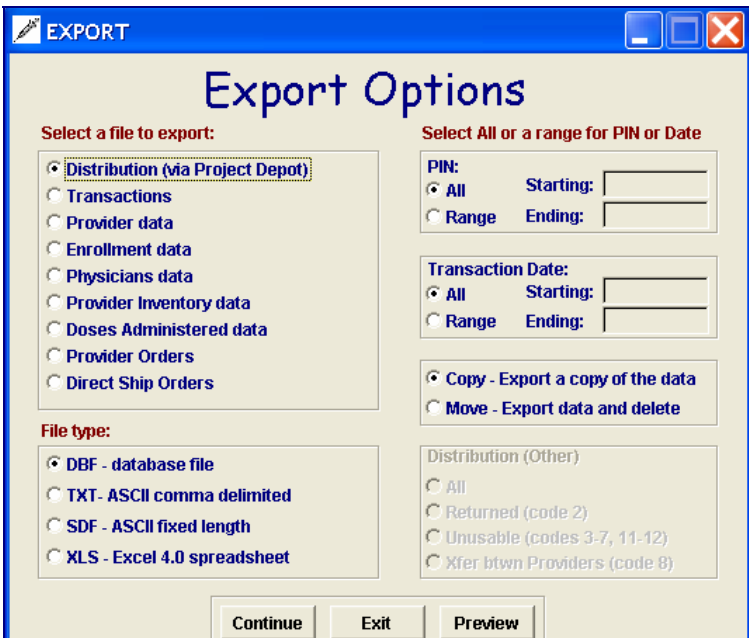

Setup	Non-CDC Vaccines	24.	 <p>Figure 13. New v4x Non-CDC Contract Vaccines screen.</p> <p>This screen displays a list of non-CDC contract vaccines that your project can distribute within VACMAN. The list is based on user input and is updated periodically.</p> <p>Activate vaccines and presentations so they will display in vaccine drop down lists. You can de-activate vaccines or presentations that you do not distribute. Also enter your project's cost for each vaccine you activate, and create vaccine shortcuts as applicable.</p>

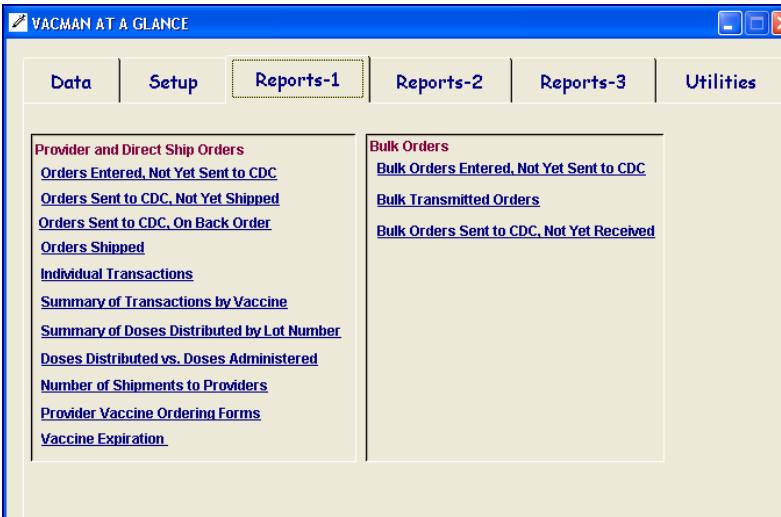
