Corps of Engineers to finish repaving roads in Mill Creek Park at Sam Rayburn Reservoir

FORT WORTH, Texas – The U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, Fort Worth District at Sam Rayburn Lake, announced today that all roads within Mill Creek Park will be repaved May 28-29, 2008, weather permitting. The paving process may cause temporary road blocks as paving material is being laid. All customer vehicles must be parked completely off park roads while paving is in progress. Boat ramps and parking lots will remain open, but may be subject to temporary road blocks. Vehicles will be allowed on park roads within minutes after paving is laid.
