## **Corps to Plan Improvements for Westlake, Oakland, Hickory Creek and Sycamore Bend Parks at Lewisville Lake**

*FORT WORTH, Texas* – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers announced today the initiation of a park planning effort for facility improvements at Westlake, Oakland, Hickory Creek and Sycamore Bend Parks, located on Lewisville Lake. This is part of the Corps' long-term effort to plan and construct major improvements to the recreational facilities at Lewisville Lake.

At this time, the Corps is requesting comments and recommendations from the public concerning present-day facilities and future recreational uses at these parks. This is an opportunity for the public to make their park facility preferences known to the Corps and to comment on operation and management issues.
