Corps of Engineers announces opening of White Flint Park on Belton Lake May 1st

New facilities to expand recreation opportunities

FORT WORTH, TEXAS – The U. S. Army Corps of Engineers at Belton and Stillhouse Hollow Lakes would like to invite the public to come out and use the new facilities at White Flint Park on Belton Lake. The park is re-opening after almost a year of construction.

White Flint Park has been upgraded with a new gatehouse, 13 back-in RV campsites with 50 amp electric and water hookups, 12 screen shelter campsites, a waterborne restroom with hot showers and a trailer dump station. The existing boat ramp and restroom also remain in service.

Fees charged at White Flint Park are as follows: RV sites \$18 per night, screen shelter campsites \$30 per night and \$3 per day will be charged for use of the boat ramp. Golden Age and Golden Access Card discounts apply.
