XML Error – Troubleshooting Guide

The table below is intended to provide assistance when XML error X0000-005 is received. The list below is not all encompassing and the examples are intended to assist in deciphering the XML error message and provide guidance on how to correct the error.

The file contained a value of 1 in a field that must be greater than or equal to 2	The XML showed a 1 in the second row of Form 851 Part I and a 2 in the third row.	If you entered these values, put a 2 in the second row of Form 851 Part I, a 3 in the third row, etc. If these values were entered by your software, contact your vendor.
2	The XML data has failed schema validation XSV code: { com.tibco.xml.validation } SIMPLE_E_INVALID_VALUE_FOR _TYPE. XSV message: data "2.0" is not a valid integer. A valid example is "123"	The value entered does not comply with the format of the field.	The XML showed a value of "2.0". To comply with the format of the field, the valid entry would be "2".	If you entered the value "2.0", correct the entry to be "2". If you entered "2", you should contact your vendor to correct the entry.
