Since 1997, Jeff Walker has worked for the Cambridge Public Health Department creating progressive community health programs for the diverse constituency of Cambridge. In his capacity as Special Projects Coordinator for Community Health Programming he has Directed Cambridge Walks, a city wide collaborative campaign to increase awareness about walking, physical activity, and healthy weight - in partnership and support of the goals of city environment and traffic departments - through initiatives such as Walk with Your Children Days, Pedometer Programs, Stair Usage Campaign, the creation and dissemination of Walking Route Cards, the School Mapping Project, Walking field trips promotion, and the Golden Shoes Campaign. Additionally he has managed bioterrorism preparedness projects such as the creation of a citywide mass smallpox vaccination plan and organized regional trainings in Bioterrorism Preparedness and HEICS. His work has also included the design, production, and delivery of several annual health promotion events and fairs; including, Women's Health Day, Gospel Health Fest, Hoops N' Health, Cover the Uninsured, a Domestic a Violence Prevention Symposium, a GLBT Health Symposium, and a Teen Dating Violence Awareness Campaign. He has also coordinated the research, writing, production, design, and editorial process of an annual multi-volume Public Health Assessment for reporting to the city of Cambridge on the health and illness trends with detailed information about the department's corresponding programmatic design.

Prior to his work for the Cambridge Public Health Department, Jeff worked for many years creating HIV prevention campaigns and designing client service delivery systems. Prior to that, Jeff worked in the publishing industry for several years.

Jeff is currently working on a Master of Art Education with a focus on Public Art and Art in Healthcare.
