Results of Awareness Focus; Reporting of Misconduct Impacting Practitioners

- Referrals from the tax practitioner
 community increased 49% from
 FY 2004 to FY 2006
- Investigations resulting from these referrals increased 67% from FY 2004
 to FY 2006
- Top three allegations reported by practitioners: Impersonation, False Statements, and Misuse of Treasury/IRS Seals



• FY 2004, 44 referrals from OI to OPR

• FY 2005, 92 referrals from OI to OPR

• FY 2006, 157 referrals from OI to OPR



FY 2004 to FY 2006, Prosecutions
 Increased from 5 to 18

- Thefts of Refunds and Remittances
- False Statements(Overstating Qualifications)
