

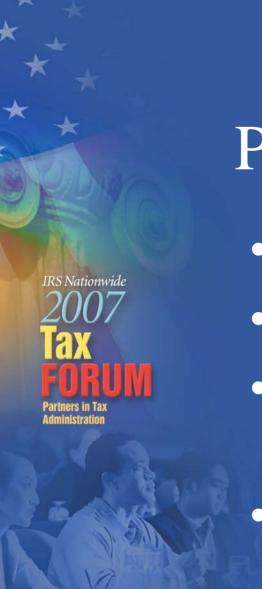


Migration of work from Philly to Austin

- January 1, 2007

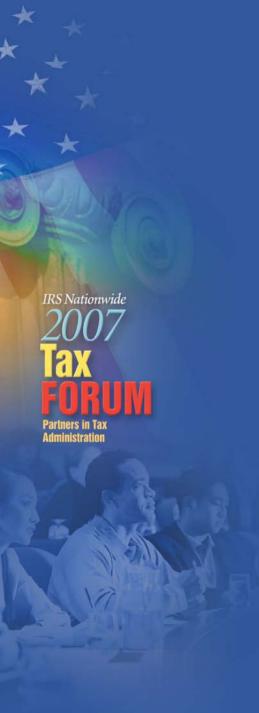

- RTS Database Conversion



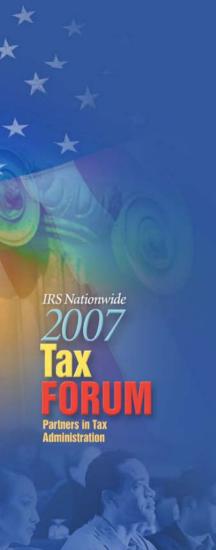
W-7 Changes for FY 07

- Form Change
 - Inclusion of EFIN/Office Code
- Instructions
 - Austin Service Center mailing address
 - Itemized list of documents to support each exception



Supporting Documentation

- 13 Acceptable documents
- Prove foreign status and identity
 - Passport proves both foreign status and identity
- Two forms of documentation required



Documentation Cont.

- Photo Identification
- Medical and School Records (children under age 14 or 18 if a student)
- Must be valid unexpired
- Apostille Foreign Notary



Documentation Cont.

- Unacceptable Documentation
 - National Health Cards Canada
 - Smile Safe Kids Cards
 - Identi-Kids
 - U.S. Aid Cards

Statistics on ITINs

- 10,771,438 ITIN Assigned since 1996
 - 1.6 Million assigned in 2006
- \$48 Billion in tax liability from 1996 through 2003
- \$23 Billion in total refunds issued from 1996 through 2003
