Little Grass Valley Recreation Area

Little Grass Valley Reservoir is located three miles north of La Porte off the La Porte Rd. The nearest store for supplies is in La Porte. Fishing, swimming, and boating. RV sanitary disposal station.

Reservations and first come first serve.

Open camp sites are available on a first come first serve basis in campgrounds within the reservation system. Campers without reservations may need to move after second night if site becomes reserved. Campgrounds are reserved through Recreation.gov (877 444-6777).

Sly Creek Recreation Area

Sly Creek CG - 10 miles north on La Porte Road from Challenge left at campground turnoff, 4 1/2 miles further. Strawberry CG - 15 miles north on La Porte Rd. from Challenge, left at campground turnoff, 2 miles further. Sly Creek Reservoir Area.

“Non Fee” Campgrounds

The following 5 campgrounds are “self service” so **no fees** are charged. All have Vault Toilets, and with the exception of Feather Falls Trailhead, have **no piped water**. **No adequate trailer space** is available with the exception of Rogers Cow Camp. There are **no trailer dump stations**.

Cleghorn Bar Campground / Elev. 3,100’

- 4 units - first come first serve
- 13 miles north of La Porte, turn off La Porte Rd. just north of Onion Valley. West on signed Rd., 10 miles to head of 4x4 road. **(4x4 Rd. difficult, last 1/4 mile at bottom, most difficult!)**

Little North Fork Campground / Elev. 4,000’

- 8 units - first come first serve
- Off Oroville-Bucks Lake road on Little North Fork of Feather River.

Milsap Bar Campground / Elev. 1,600’

- 20 units
- Take Oroville-Bucks Lake Road to Brush Creek Work Center then follow signs 8 miles to Milsap Bar.

Rogers Cow Camp / Elev. 4,000’

- 5 units - first come first serve
- 8 miles north of Brush Creek, turn left off of Oroville-Bucks Lake Road.

Feather Falls Trailhead / Elev. 2,500’

- 5 units - first come first serve
- From Oroville take Oro Dam Blvd. to Olive Hwy., turn right. Take Olive Hwy. approximately 5 miles to Forbestown Rd., turn right go 7 miles. Turn left on Lumpkin Rd., continue 12 miles to trailhead turn off, turn left, and go 1.5 miles further.
