Dave Harmon Logging High Bidder on BLM Timber Sale

Klamath Falls, OR - The Klamath Falls Resource Area of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) held the Buck 13 Timber Sale on September 17.

The tract of timber offered is in Klamath County, approximately 30 miles west of Klamath Falls. The sale is estimated to contain 535 thousand board feet of timber with an appraised value of \$26,579.90.

Dave Harmon Logging was the high bidder at the event at \$109,678.30. Other qualified bidders participating in the sale were Ed Pariera, Curtis Wicks, Farmer Logging and Jon Sheppard.
