Interpretive Center to extend hours April 1

BAKER CITY, Oregon – Beginning April 1, The National Historic Oregon Trail Interpretive Center will be open from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily. This extends the visiting window by two hours from its winter operating schedule of 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

The National Historic Oregon Trail Interpretive Center is 5 miles east of Baker City on Highway 86. Take Exit 302 from I-84. For more information call (541) 523-1843 or visit oregontrail.blm.gov. The Interpretive Center is operated by the Bureau of Land Management and is a federal fee site. Children 15 and under are free. Admission for adults is \$5. Federal passes are accepted.
