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Rotavirus Vaccines 2006/7 Live, oral

- Attenuated monovalent human rotavirus vaccine: Rotarix ® (GSK)
 - BLA submitted to FDA June 1, 2007
 - Studied as two-dose series at ages 2, 4 months
- Pentavalent human-bovine reassortant rotavirus vaccine: RotaTeq® (Merck)
 - Licensed Feb 2006
 - ACIP recommendations Feb 2006
 - Routine infant vaccination at ages 2, 4, 6 months 3

Rotavirus Vaccines Presentations to ACIP

- October 2007
 - Rotarix: safety and efficacy data, by GSK
 - RotaTeq: safety update, coverage and age-adherence estimates
- February 2008
 - Draft of WG proposed recommendations
- June 2008
 - Possible ACIP vote on proposed recommendations (if Rotarix licensed)
 - New ACIP statement on Rotavirus Vaccines

Rotavirus Vaccines Working Group Plans and progress

- Review data on Rotarix
- Draft proposed recommendations
 - Rotarix
 - Address issues with two products
- Continue to review post-marketing data on RotaTeq
 - ISO, FDA

 - Available data
 - Expectations and timeline for additional data
 - Opinion of working group members
 - Programmatic issues

 - Special populations
 - Special circumstances
 - Contraindications
 - Precautions
- Review any additional information on safety and efficacy
- Review cost-effectiveness data for Rotarix
