INTRODUCTION

The Department of Defense *Financial Management Regulation* (DoD FMR) is issued under the authority of DoD Instruction 7000.14, "DoD Financial Management Policy and Procedures." The DoD FMR directs statutory and regulatory financial management requirements, systems, and functions for all appropriated and non-appropriated, working capital, revolving, and trust fund activities.
