

Request your assistance to make changes to DoD FMR, Table 29-2, Special Initial Clothing Allowance – Effective October 1, 2006 and Table 29-6. Air Force Supplementary Clothing Allowances.

Table 29-2, Special Initial Clothing Allowance, should be reflected as follows:

These increases are consistent with the multipliers applied for FY01-06 and represent a long overdue increase. Additionally, for the upcoming Fiscal Year 2008-2013 Program and Budget Review (PBR) Call, the AFUB is recommending an average 2% increase to both tables per year. The office of the Comptroller, advises each Service what the MilPers non-pay inflation factor will be for each FY.

With the projected decrease in Air Force end strength, actual numbers of personnel in the respective categories in the above tables will fluctuate and therefore costs will vary as well.
