An interim correction to pages 1 and 2 of the TERPS Order is attached. Remove the old pages 1 and 2 and replace them with the attached new pages 1 and 2. These pages contain the following corrections:

Paragraph 1. Reworded to simplify.

Paragraph 4. Reworded to gain relief from requirement for existing procedure to immediately comply with TERPS amendments.

Paragraph 5. Reorganized to specify four types of procedures: Precision Approach (PA), Approach with Vertical Guidance (APV), Nonprecision Approach (NPA), and Departure Procedures (DP).

Paragraph 121. Reworded to simplify.

Paragraph 122a. Reworded to simplify. Wording more clearly indicates adherence to AC 150/5340-1 and AC 150/5300-13 is necessary to achieve lowest minimums, and non-adherence could result in higher minimums. Previous wording led to the erroneous interpretation that adherence to the ACs was necessary for the procedure approval.

Paragraph 122c. Last sentence reworded to indicate obstacle shielding does not always relieve a requirement for removal or marking/lighting.

This TIL will be canceled by a future TERPS change.
