Plant-A-Tree

What is "Plant-A-Tree"?

The Forest Service established this special program to enable persons and organizations to donate money for planting trees on national forests. Trees are commonly planted in memory of a loved one or to commemorate birthdays, retirements, and other events. These contributions qualify as charitable contributions under the Internal Revenue Service Code. All contributions are deposited in a specific account designated for this program.

What is needed for the Forest Service to issue a certificate?

A letter from the donator stating:

- Name, address, and phone number of person making the contribution
- Type of donation: Memorial, wedding, birthday, or anniversary
- Check made out to the Superior National Forest/USDA Forest Service for the amount of the donation
- Who the donation is in name of (example: in memory of Aunt X)
- Name and address of who the certificate is to be sent to
