














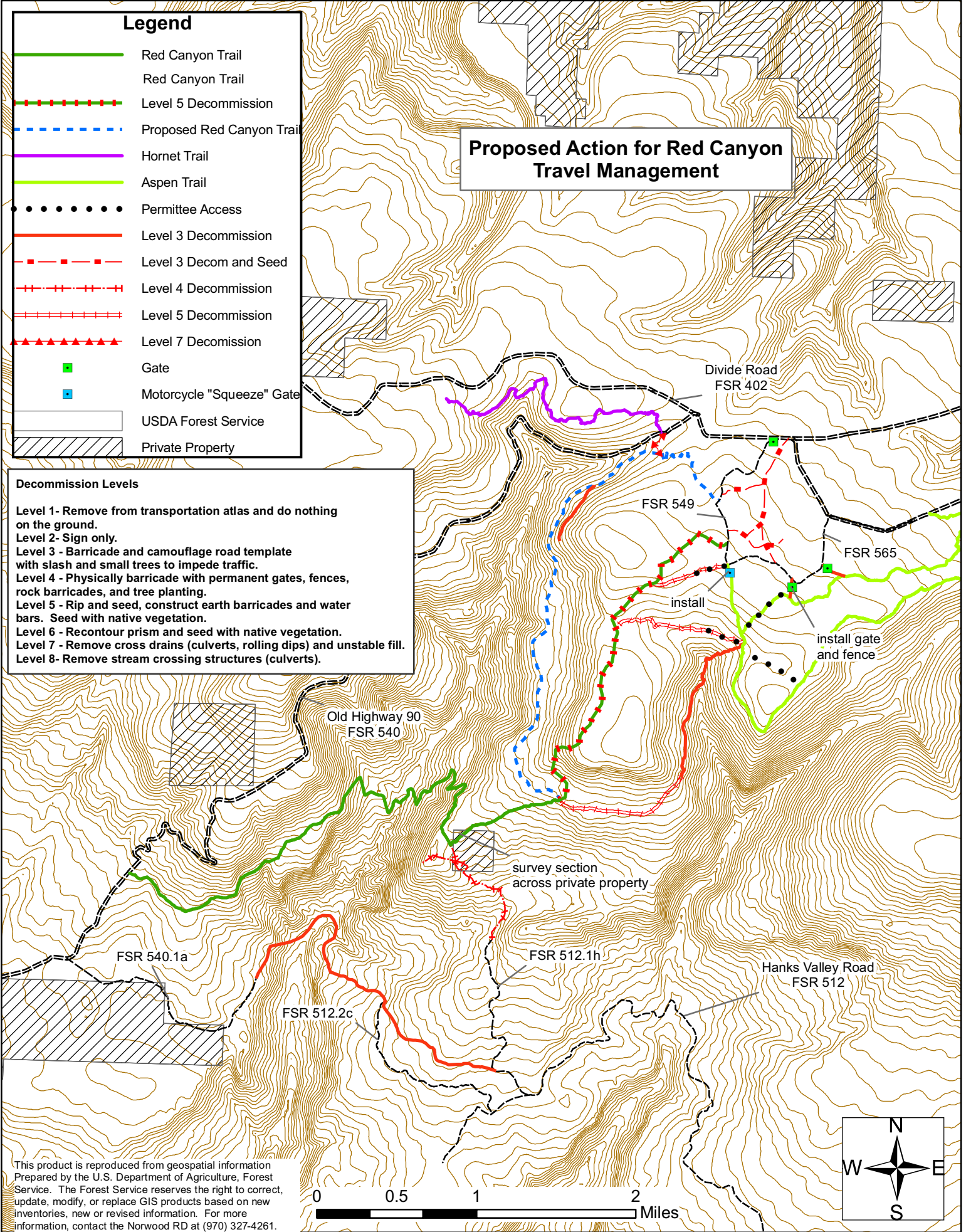

Proposed Action for Red Canyon Travel Management

- ### Decommission Levels
- Level 1- Remove from transportation atlas and do nothing on the ground.
 - Level 2- Sign only.
 - Level 3 - Barricade and camouflage road template with slash and small trees to impede traffic.
 - Level 4 - Physically barricade with permanent gates, fences, rock barricades, and tree planting.
 - Level 5 - Rip and seed, construct earth barricades and water bars. Seed with native vegetation.
 - Level 6 - Recontour prism and seed with native vegetation.
 - Level 7 - Remove cross drains (culverts, rolling dips) and unstable fill.
 - Level 8- Remove stream crossing structures (culverts).



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
