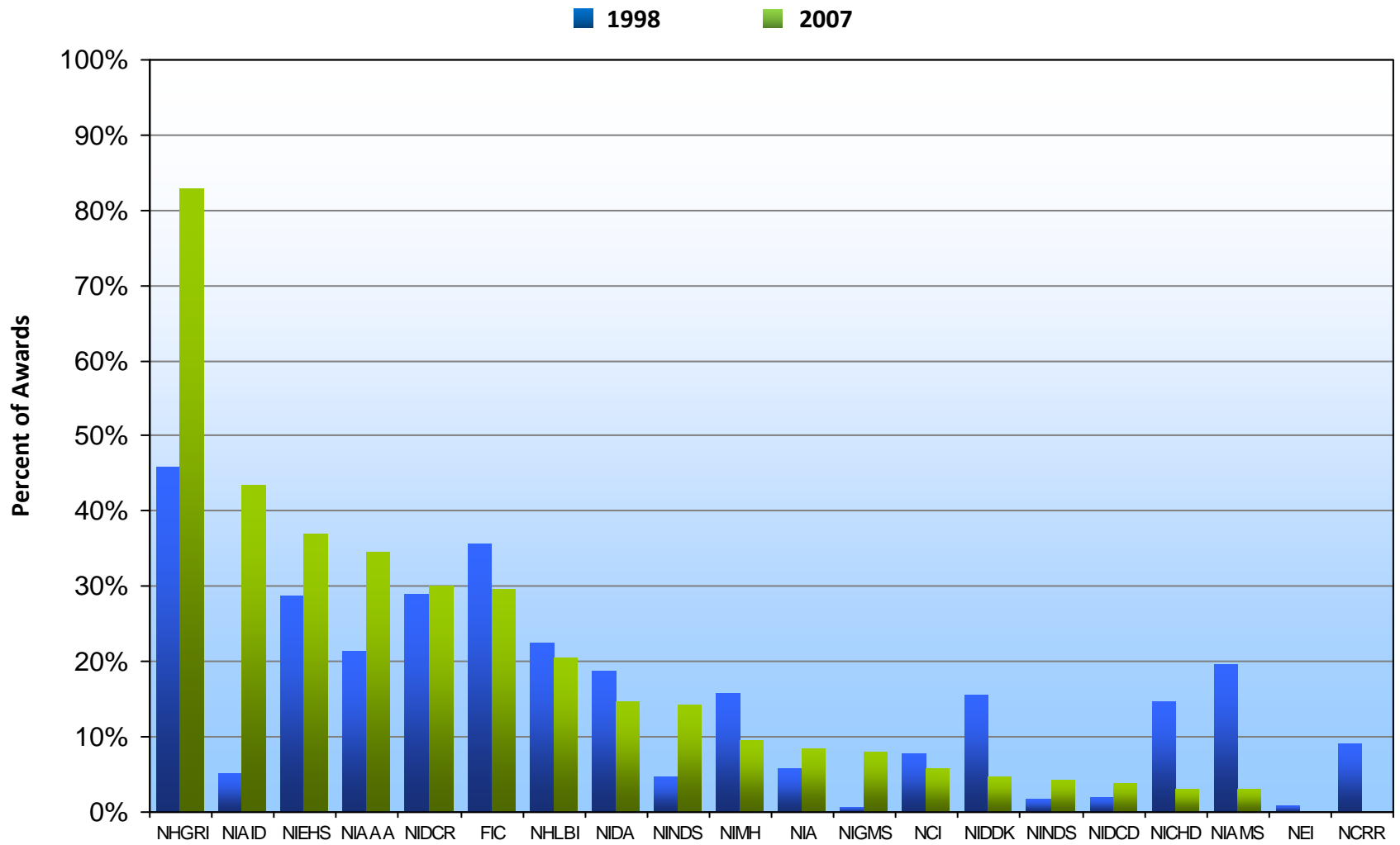

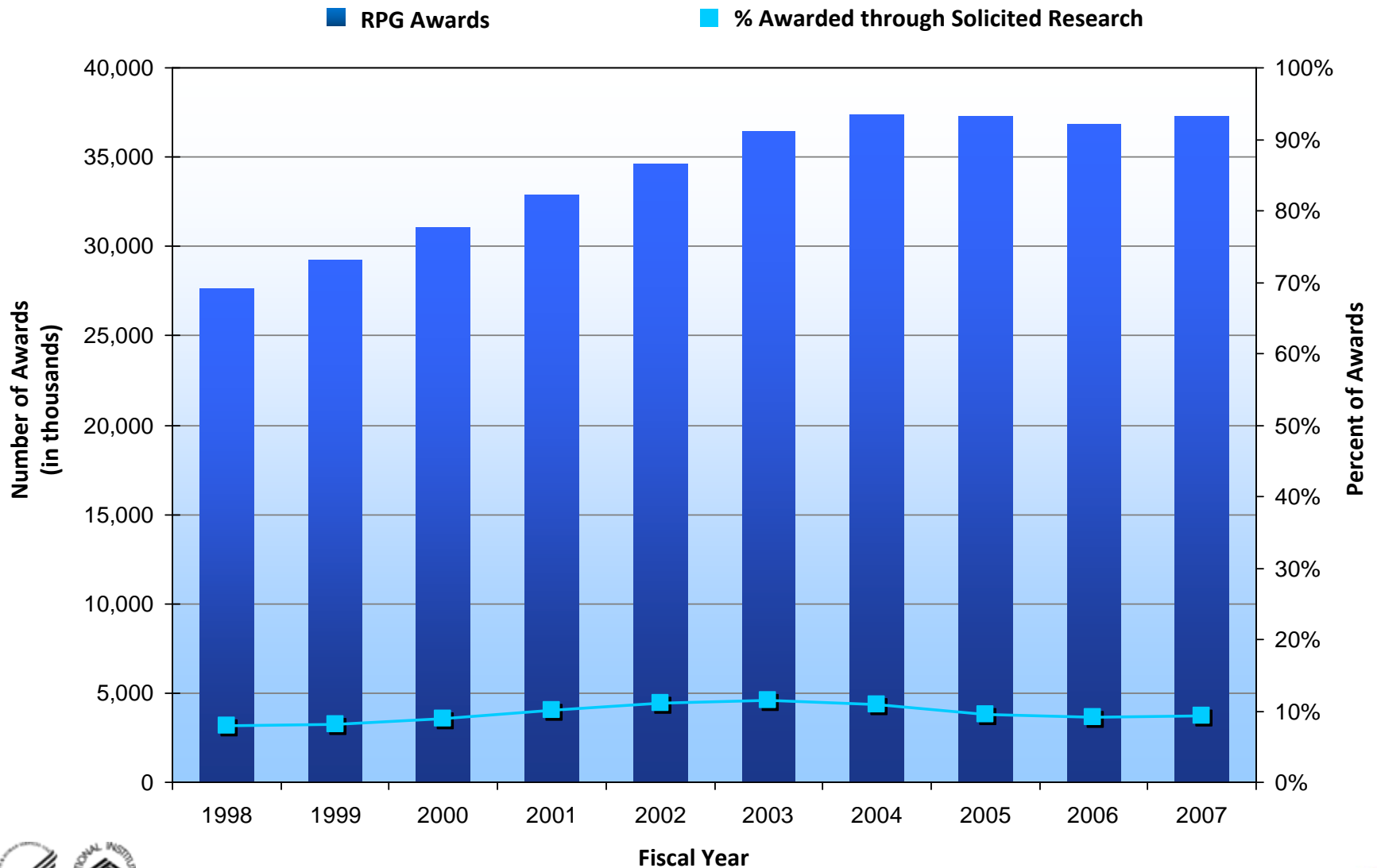
1998: NIH Total = 12.1%

2007: NIH Total = 22.0%



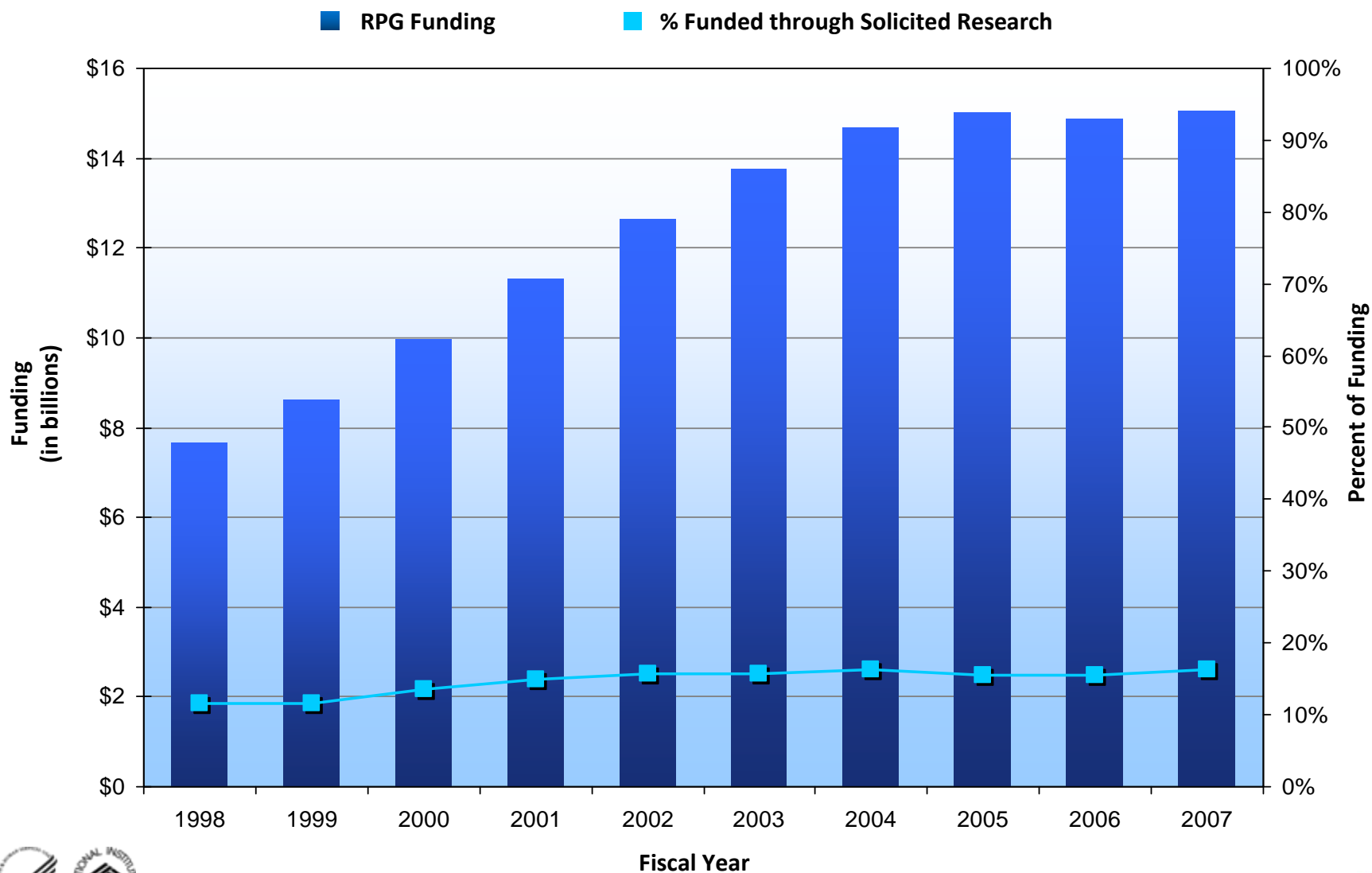


RESEARCH PROJECT GRANTS AWARDED THROUGH SOLICITED RESEARCH



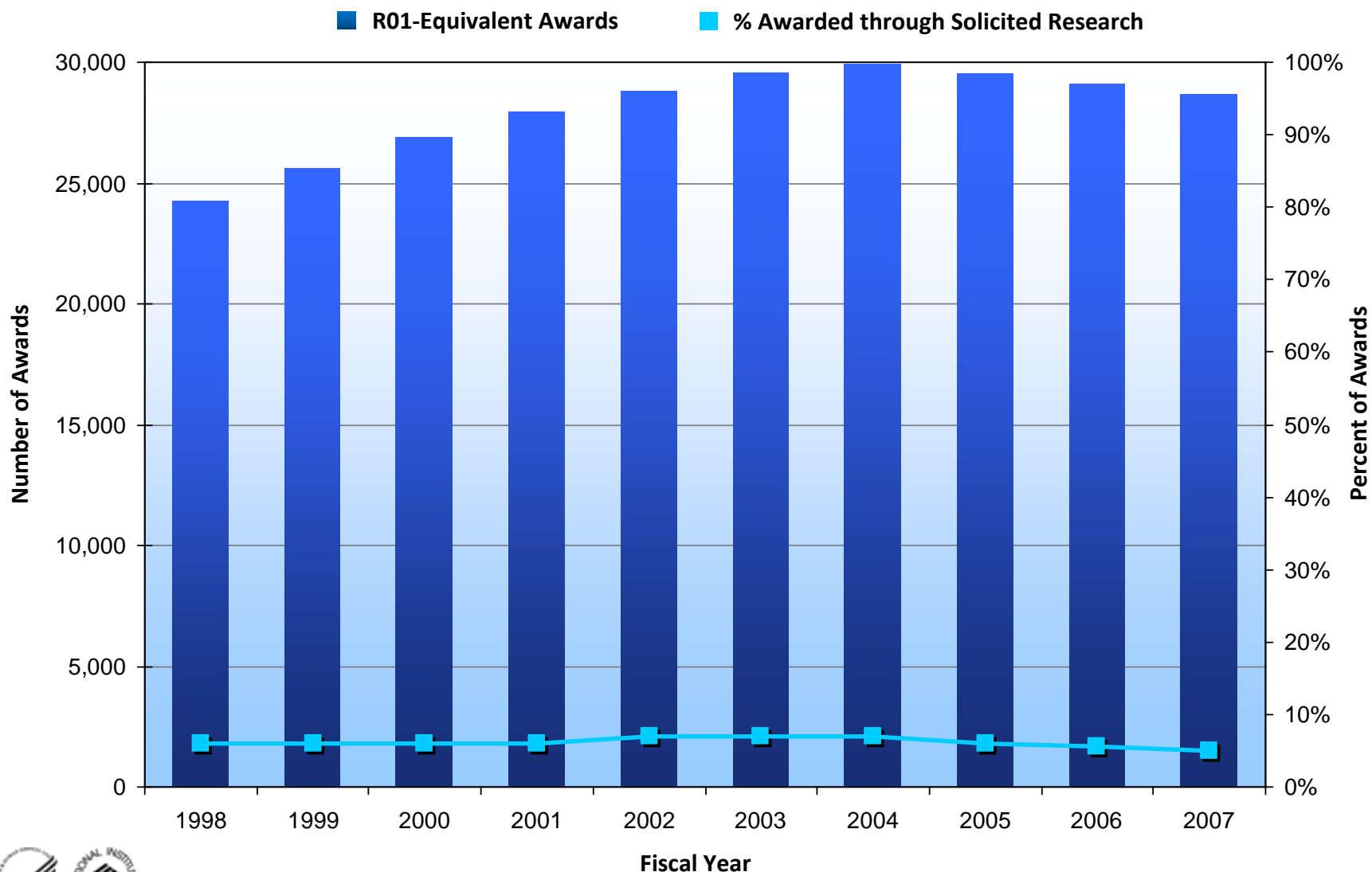


RESEARCH PROJECT GRANT FUNDING THROUGH SOLICITED RESEARCH



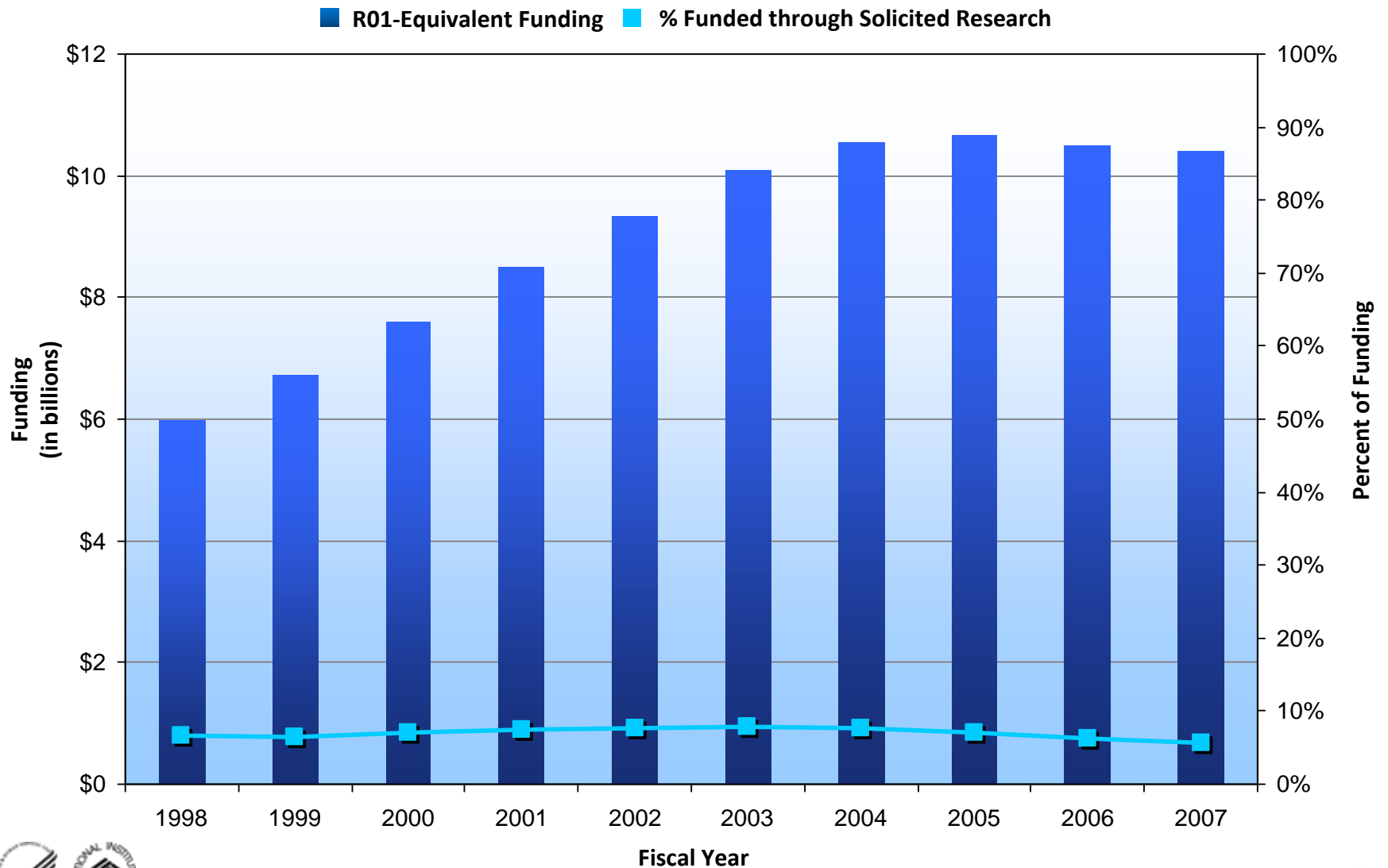


R01-EQUIVALENT GRANTS AWARDED THROUGH SOLICITED RESEARCH



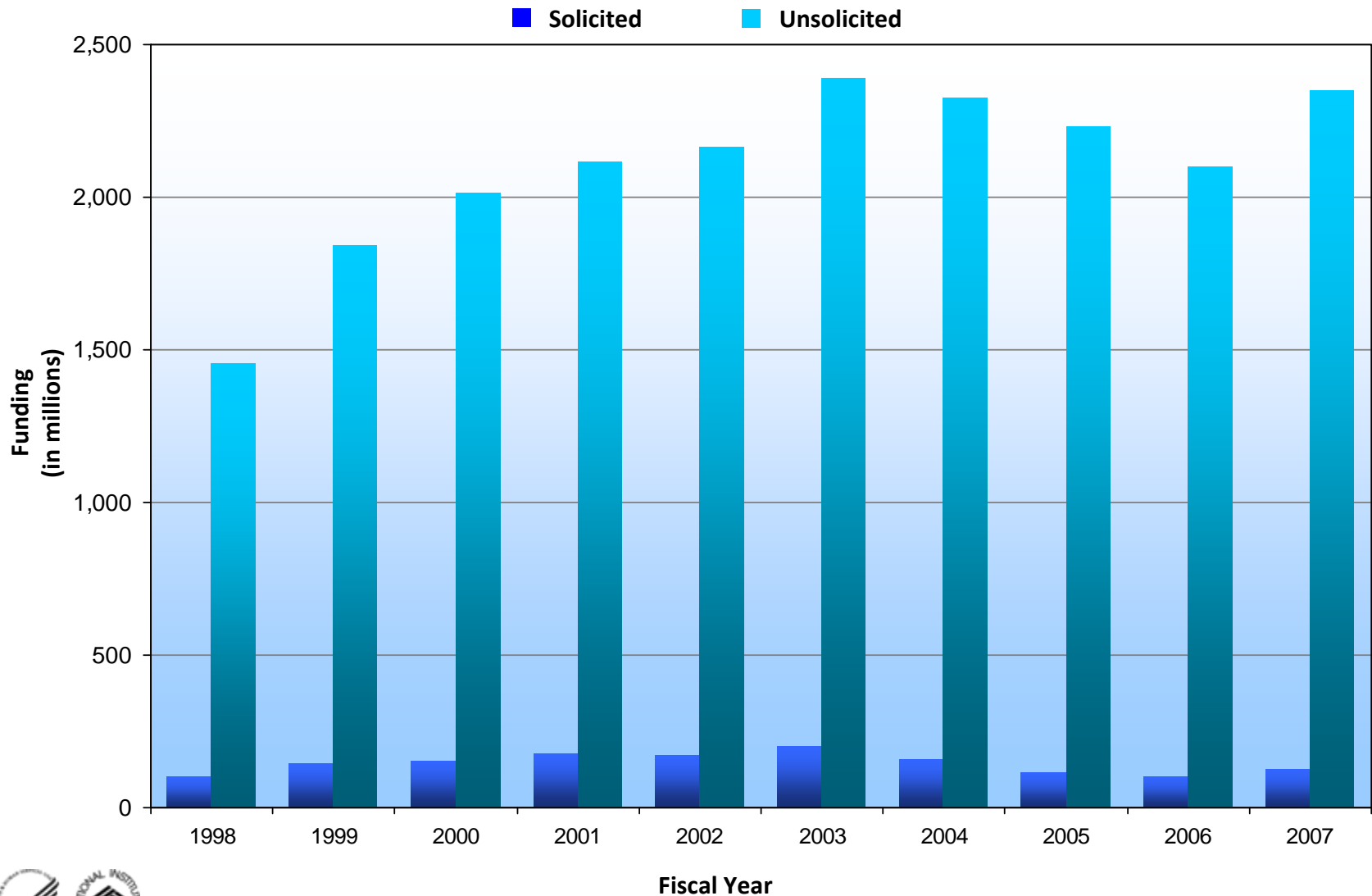

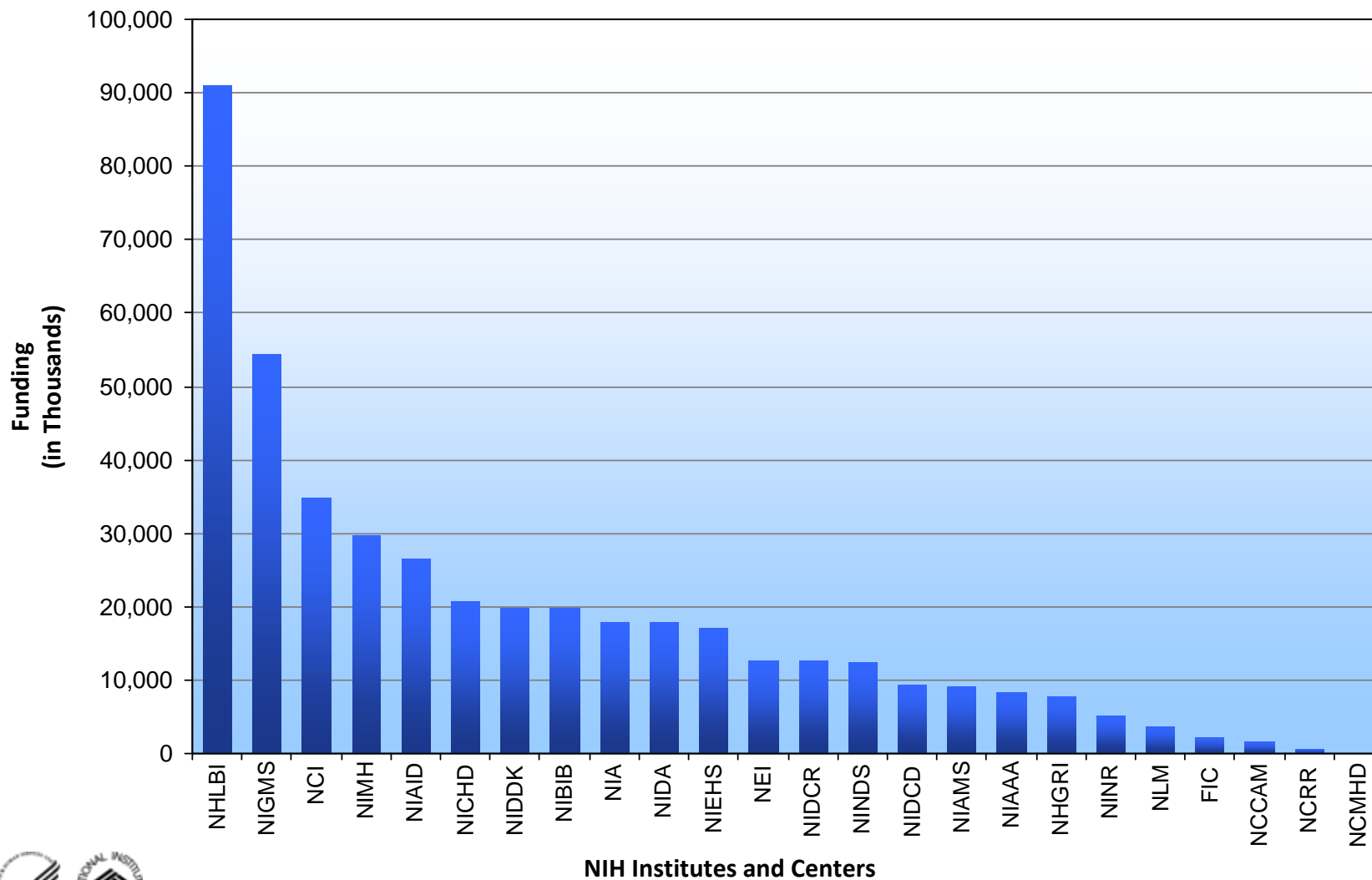


FUNDING OF SOLICITED AND UNSOLICITED COMPETING R01-EQUIVALENT GRANTS





FUNDING OF SOLICITED R01-EQUIVALENT GRANTS BY INSTITUTES AND CENTERS FY 2007

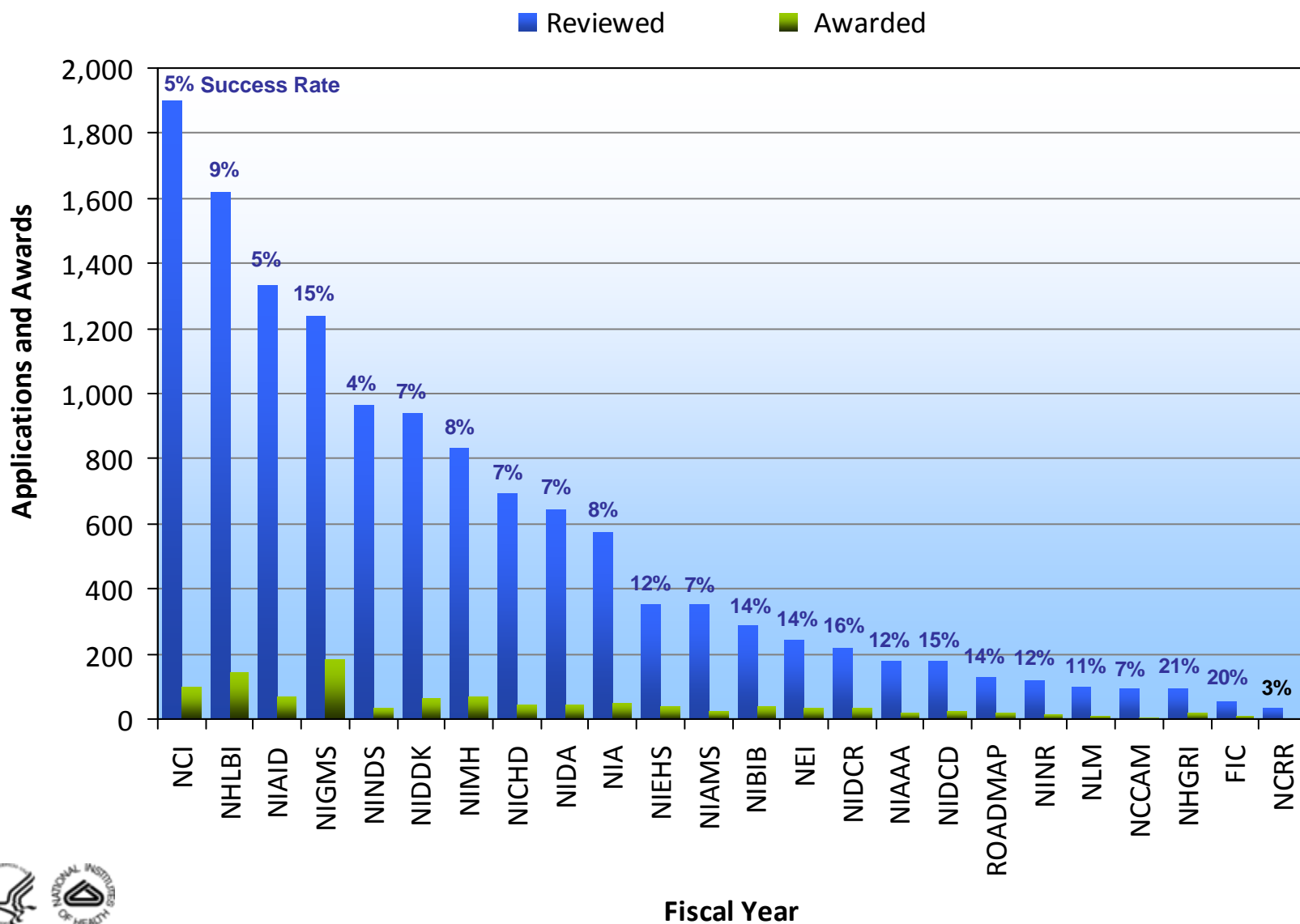

SUCCESS RATES OF SOLICITED R01-EQUIVALENT GRANTS BY INSTITUTES AND CENTERS FY 2007

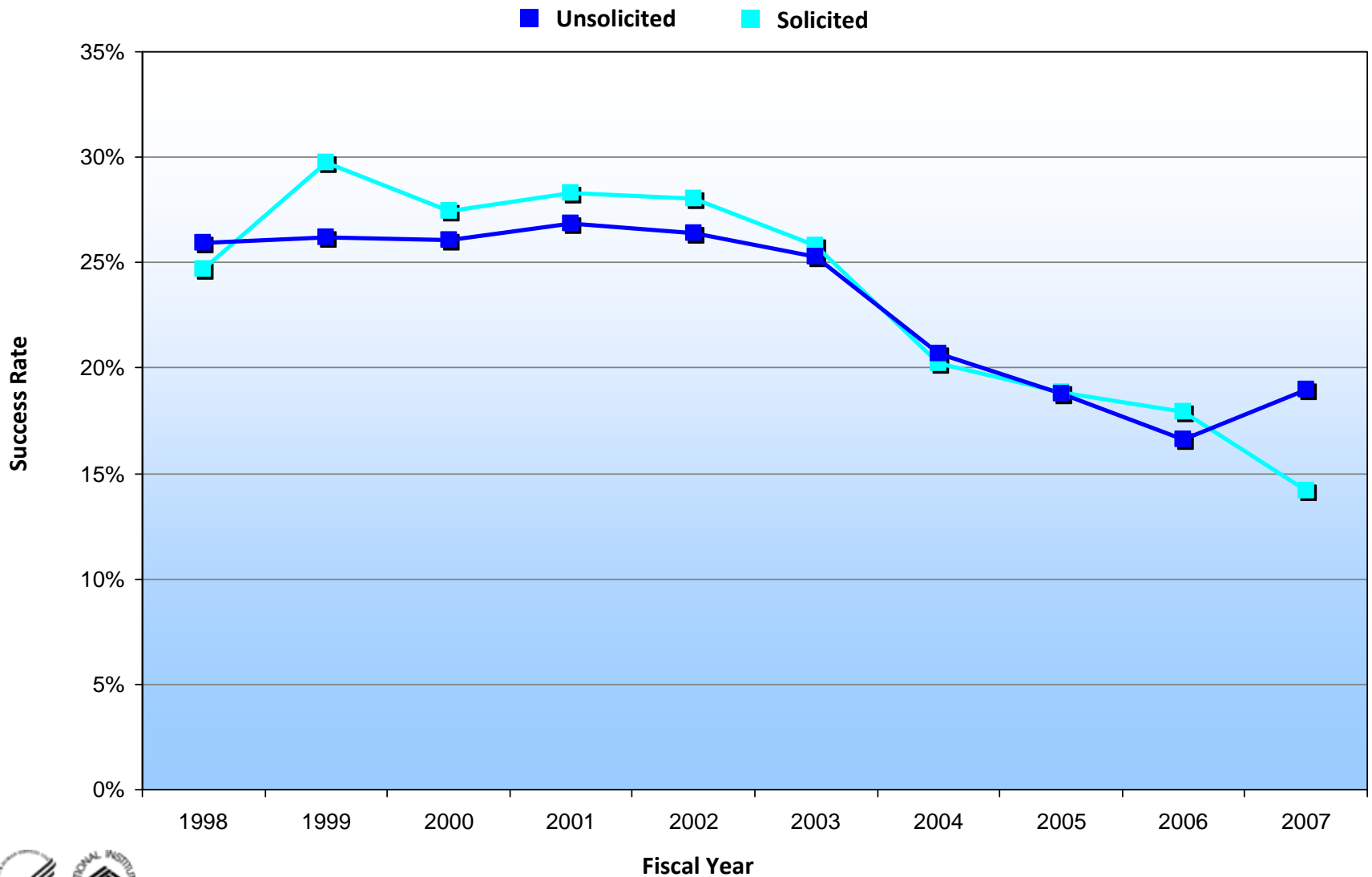

TERM	DEFINITION	ADDITIONAL INFORMATION
New Application (Type 1)	Request for Department of Health and Human Services support of a project that has not yet been funded	
Program Announcement (PA)	An announcement by an NIH Institute or Center requesting applications in the stated scientific areas. Program Announcements (PA) are published in the NIH Guide for Grants and Contracts.	Funding Opportunities and Notices – NIH Guide for Grants and Contracts
R01-Equivalent Grants	A subset of research project grants which includes R01, R23, R29 and R37 activities.	
Research Grants	Extramural awards made for Other Research Grants, Research Centers, Research Projects, and SBIR/STTRs. Includes the following: R, P, M, S, K, U series (excluding UC6) DP1, DP2, D42, G12.	
Research Project Grants (RPG's)	Include R00, R01, R03, R15, R21, R22, R23, R29, R33, R34, R35, R36, R37, R55, R56, RL1, RL5, RL9, P01, P42, PN1, UC1, UC7, U01, U19, U34, DP1, DP2, RL1, RL2, RL5, RL9. Also includes RPG's from NLM as of FY07.	Activity Code Descriptions
Request for Application (RFA)	The official statement inviting grant or cooperative agreement applications to accomplish a specific program purpose. RFAs indicate the amount of funds set aside for the competition and generally identify a single application receipt date	Funding Opportunities and Notices – NIH Guide for Grants and Contracts
Solicited Awards	Responses to Requests for Applications (RFA's)

Success Rates	<p>Indicates the percentage of reviewed RPG applications receiving funding computed on a fiscal year basis. It is determined by dividing the number of competing applications funded by the sum of the total number of competing applications reviewed and the number of funded carryovers.</p> <p>NOTE: Applications having one or more amendments in the same fiscal year are only counted once.</p>
