SUBJECT: TITLE XIX OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT, PAYMENT OF MEDICARE PART B PREMIUMS

STATUTORY REFERENCES o Sections 1902(a)(10)(E), 1905(p)(3)(a)(ii), and 1933 of the Social Security Act.

BACKGROUND: o Section 4732 of the Balanced Budget Act of 1997 establishes a capped allocation for each of five years beginning January 1998, to States for payment of Medicare Part B premiums for two new mandatory eligibility groups of low-income Medicare beneficiaries, called Qualifying Individuals or QIs.

If you require legislation (other than appropriating funds) in order to amend your State plan, request a delayed effective date through the regional office.
