Final Spud Cabin Fire Update

On July 13, three firefighters continued to mop-up the Spud Cabin Fire, further securing the perimeter. The general area of the fire received limited precipitation on Thursday evening. Some interior smoke is expected to persist until the area receives a significant amount of rain. The fire will be in monitor status, beginning July 14, and will only be staffed if necessary. The Spud Cabin Fire remains at 4.8 acres and is 100% contained.
