VOLUNTEER SHERIFF'S POSSE ORGANIZATIONS REGULATION OF TRAFFIC FOR SPECIAL EVENTS BY SHERIFF'S POSSE ORDINANCE NO. 4

An ordinance authorizing volunteer sheriff's posse organizations to regulate traffic at special events; and providing for an effective date.

Upon approval of the sheriff or his designee, duly qualified members of a volunteer posse organization established in accordance with A. R. S. Section 11-441 D. may provide traffic regulation services, in connection with special events in the country. In providing such services, a posse member may utilize vehicles and other equipment of the Sheriff's office to the extent and in the manner authorized by the Sheriff or his designee.

This ordinance shall become effective on the day it is adopted.
