

college graduates may be hired at the GS-5 or GS-7 Federal grade level. Others with advanced degrees and experience may be hired at higher grade levels, and there is substantial opportunity for advancement! To begin a career as a Teacher in the Forest Service Job Corps Program, you must meet the following requirements: Have a degree in elementary or secondary education from an accredited university, supplemented by supervised student teaching,

OR

A combination of education and experience – for each year short of graduation, the applicant must have had 1 year of teaching experience at the elementary or secondary level as appropriate to the position to be filled.
