Categories of National Forest System Lands Within New Mexico


IRA, allows road construction or reconstruction	4% (381,000 acres)
IRA, does not allow road construction or reconstruction	12% (1,102,000 acres)
IRA, recommended wilderness	1% (66,000 acres)
Designated Areas outside of IRAs	16% (1,469,000 acres)
All Other National Forest System Lands	68% (6,309,000 acres)
